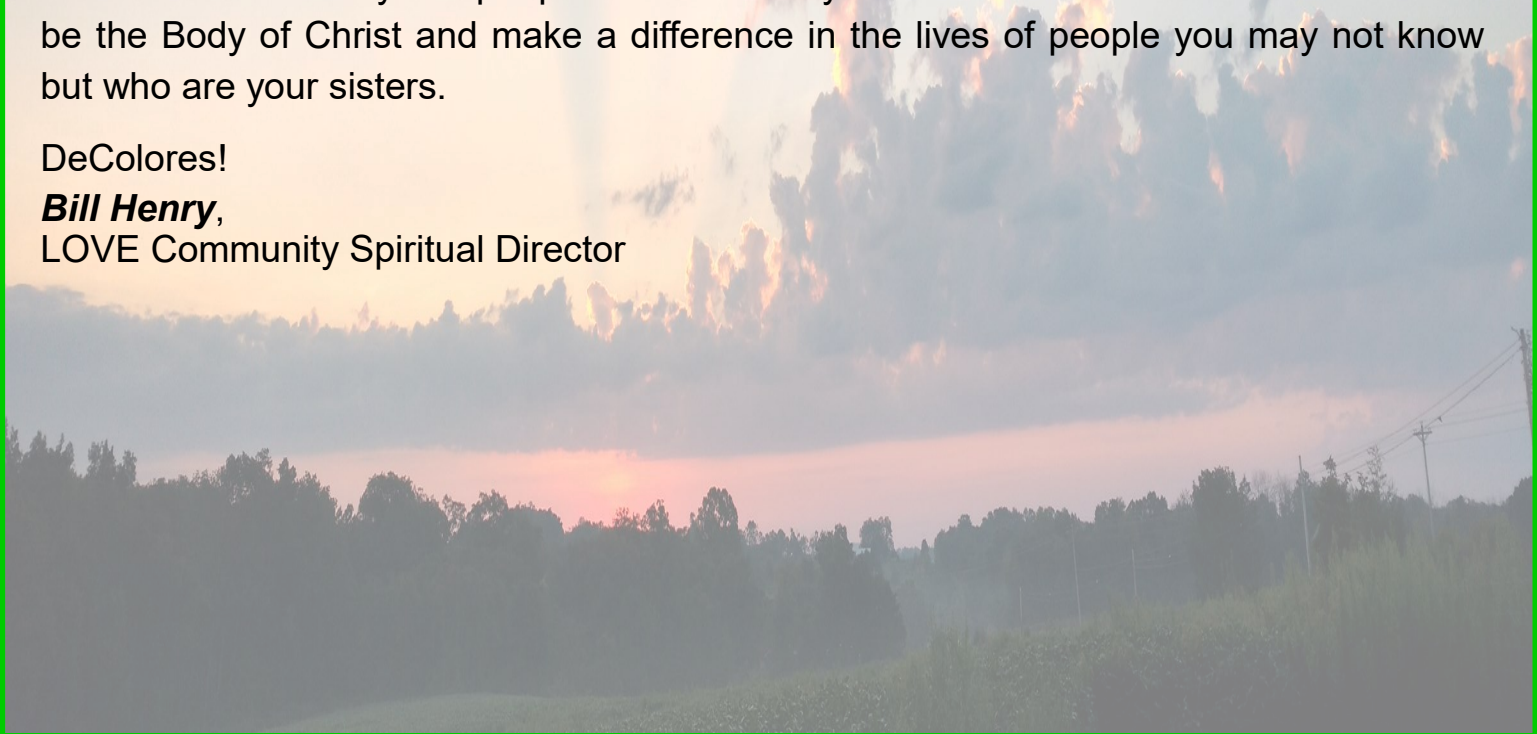


From The Community Spiritual Director
