

ADMISSION

Wings staff will inventory your child's personal belongings on the day of admission. Any items our staff feels are inappropriate will go into storage until your child is discharged from Wings.

Wings discourages clients from entering Wings with high value clothing as the setting increases vulnerability for personal property loss or damage.

Wings will provide towels and bedding for each client, on-site laundry with detergent will be provided.

- Please limit clothing to 10-12 days for your child. We have very limited storage for suitcases.
- Clothing Rules:
 - Jeans with rips and holes above the knees
 - Leggings must be of 'Solid' material. No leggings with mesh sides, or cut-outs
 - Short must cover the entire groin area and have at least a 3 inches inseam.
 - Clothing must cover chest area, stomach, underwear, buttocks and genitals in all public areas of the building.
 - No V-neck t-shirts
 - No off the shoulder shirts
 - Gang related t-shirt (flashing colors) Zero tolerance!
- Jewelry
 - Clients are allowed to possess jewelry with spiritual value, these items must be checked out from the med room and utilized in 1 hour increments only. These items cannot be worn on a daily basis.
 - Clients are permitted upon Wings medical team authorization to utilize plastic, rubber jewelry, gages, or piercings to hold a piercing that has been assessed at high risk for closure.
 - Jewelry and piercings, that are metal or precious gems, gages or piercings are prohibited and must be removed prior to admission
 - Clients are permitted to wear yarn jewelry or rubber bracelets or anklets created in the treatment setting
 - Clients may not have in their possession any jewelry with sharp edges
- Clients can have two additional inventories of no more than ten items. Once a client has exceeded two
- additional inventories, no more items will be allowed.
- Clients will need a good pair of gym shoes
- Swim trunks/swimsuit

ADMISSION

- Weather appropriate clothing
 - If your child is at Wings during the winter month, please be sure your child has a winter jacket, boots, hat, and mittens. Your child will be going outdoors!
- Clients are allowed to bring 10 make-up items. Mirrors must be removed from cosmetic compacts. NO GLASS bottles.
- Personal hygiene items coming into the facility must be unused and in sealed containers/bottles (body lotion, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, etc.)
- Clients are allowed to bring hair dryers, curling iron/flat irons etc. These items will be kept in our med room and will need to be checked out from staff daily and returned after use.
- No bobby pins or metal hair clips
- NO personal blankets or pillows
- Upon request and approved by Wings Director. Clients will be allowed to have one unused plush toy, it must be in a seal package
- No spiral notebooks or sharpies
