Dropping off and collecting your child- Just a reminder of drop off & collection times;

Children booked in from 8.30am we ask that you arrive between 8.30-8.40am. Children booked from 9am, the side gate will be open between 8.55-9.10am to enable staggered drop offs. Anybody arriving after this time needs to knock the main door.

Also please notify us if someone different will be collecting your child, the person collecting will need identification and the password on your registration form. If you need to collect your child early for any reason, please phone/email to inform us.

All parents are welcome to come into the setting when dropping off your child. Please keep this as brief as possible and allow your child to organise their own bags etc. When picking your child please wait outside your child's door and they will be sent out to you.

On arrival- Children's Self-registration system for children that supports early maths skills. Staff will show your child what to do!

The 4 o'clock club and 8.30 early start can be used as part of funded hours or on an ad-hoc/emergency basis. If you need to use this service, then book in with either Nikki or Emma or email the setting to arrange this. Payment for the additional hours will need to be paid within 7 days of the invoice being issued.

Communication between home and preschool is essential in the smooth running of the preschool.

All information shared will be in confidence and only discussed with staff on a need-to-know basis.
