Dear Friends and Family,

It is amazing to think that we have been in Ireland now for over five months! We are continually amazed at how good the Lord is. It has been such a privilege to help out the ministry here at Bible Baptist Church in Ballincollig. We have learned so much already about the culture and what it means to be in the ministry full time! Our days are packed and we love being involved! March was a very busy time for us personally. We started a College & Career ministry and had thirteen singles come to our house for the first activity. This group has so much potential for serving the Lord with us in the church. Cork is a big college town, and the university is just a few miles away from us. Please pray that we can find a way to impact these college students.

March was also filled with several holidays and big days. Ireland celebrates Mother's Day the second weekend in March, and we had a big promotion and soul-winning blitz for it. There was one person saved after knocking on his door and then following up. We taught Sunday School (a children's church) and had an average of 27 children during March. Since we have just one room for all of the children, we have different people teach the children's Sunday School every month. This is a way to train Sunday School teachers for the church in anticipation of the day when we have a building of our own and can have several different classes. We also celebrated St. Patrick's Day, Ireland's national holiday, and then finished up with Resurrection Sunday. We took over discipling a Nigerian couple every Thursday evening. In addition, Jennifer and I are going through the discipling program ourselves on Tuesday evenings. On Fridays we help out in the Reformer's Unanimous ministry. Needless to say, it was a busy month!

I have been asked to lead the soul-winning outreach for the church, and that has kept me very busy trying to learn the area and send people out. We have been averaging about fifteen people going out soul winning every Saturday afternoon to tell others the greatest news they could hear – the Gospel!

In April we had our annual Men's Camp. The camp went great! We had 68 men and boys from all over Ireland and Scotland attending. We learned about the life of Moses and applying it to our lives today. Studying about Moses and listening to the messages was a blessing to me personally!

Since we have arrived, there have been three saved through the ministries of the church, and these folks are beginning to attend the church services when possible. David Murphy was saved during the Mother's Day blitz and has been attending church on Sunday morning faithfully. He is truly enjoying learning about the Bible, and he has so many questions! Please pray that his wife will also get saved and will want to come to church.
