



## I Peter 1:6 - The Believer's Great Joy

*"Wherein ye greatly rejoice"*

1. The **Action** of our Joy. *Rejoice*
  - a. If you're not rejoicing, your joy is **weakening**.
  - b. Rejoicing is joy in **action**: joy **produces** rejoicing.
  - c. Rejoicing **exercises** your joy: rejoicing **strengthens** joy.
  - d. Two important times to rejoice:
    - 1) When you **feel** joyful.
    - 2) When you **don't** feel any joy.
  
2. The **Magnitude** of our Joy. *ye greatly rejoice*
  - a. **Properly**: appropriate to the **occasion**
  - b. **Exuberantly**: **jumping** for joy
  - c. **Triumphantly**: celebrating the **victory**
  
3. The **Fuel** of our Joy. *Wherein*
  - a. The **fact** of our salvation
  - b. The **truths** of our salvation
  - c. The **God** of our salvation
