UPDATE ON PLANS TO RETURN TO FORMAL WORSHIP

A subcommittee has been formed, with representation from all age groups in our congregation, to discuss how we will come back and what precautions will be observed. This subcommittee will bring recommendations to the Spiritual Life Committee to review, and they in return, will report back to Consistory at the June meeting. As your leadership, we are trying to be proactive during this difficult time.

Conditions with COVID-19 continue to change daily, so we will be diligent in keeping up with the latest recommendations from Governor DeWine and the UCC.
