

While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who heard the word. The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astounded that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles, for they heard them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter said, "Can anyone withhold the water for baptizing these people who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?"

So he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they invited him to stay for several days.

-Acts 10: 44-48 (NRSV)

A Natural Flow

"Forgiven to offer forgiveness."

"Redeemed to be redeemers."

"Liberated to be liberators."

"Saved to share salvation."

The heart of Christian discipleship is found in sentiments such as the ones above. Yes: we are called to pursue personal transformation and sanctification (through The Spirit's power), but simultaneously, we are to be a SENT people.

That's the thrust of the Resurrection Season. Every time Jesus appeared to the disciples prior to his ascension, he ministered to their broken hearts and offered grace toward their sin and error, but he also commanded and commissioned them to go out into the rest of the world and share The Gospel. Their own encounters with The Resurrected One were merely the *beginning* of the story and never an end unto-themselves.

As we stand in the halfway point between Easter and Pentecost (May 20th), it

is good for us to remember that the resurrection of Jesus was flowing toward the giving of The Holy Spirit. That gift was for the purpose of speaking across all human/social boundaries, so that The Word of Life might flow from the believers outward, and EVERYONE might hear The Good News of GOD's Mercy.

So the question for us Christians today (and always) is:

"How are The LORD's blessings flowing through my life and out into the rest of Creation?"

As we approach the time in the church-year when we celebrate and seek to embrace the fire, wind and water of The Spirit more fully, it is an opportunity to prayerfully consider in what ways we are being called and equipped to practice evangelism and more expansively share the faith which gives us hope, meaning, purpose and peace, for this life and The Life to Come.

I'm blessed to say that our congregation is always asking this —and discovering new ways to engage our high calling from Christ. **May our** efforts receive a double outpouring of The \$pirit's anointing in the days ahead!
