


No Greater Love: A Biblical Walk Through Christ's Passion

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension of Our Lord Parish,

This past summer, I began praying about what we can do with some of our vacant office spaces. After some prayer and research, I began conversations with Mayslake Ministries located in Downers Grove to see if they would be interested in moving onto our parish campus. As you know, we have plenty of space here at the parish and since we have made some wonderful improvements to our campus through the Revitalize and Rejoice campaign, it only makes sense to maximize on our parish investment.

Beginning April 1, 2020, Mayslake Ministries will officially be moving onto our campus. They will be located in what is currently the Religious Education Reception Office and my office space as Director. These two office spaces have the ability to remain separate from the rest of the parish offices to provide privacy on both ends. I am happily relocating to another office space that is currently empty. We have decided on a two-year lease agreement. This agreement will be a win-win. It will provide Mayslake Ministries with more space and it will provide the parish with additional income. There may even be times where we will collaborate regarding ministry! Above all, I am very happy that we can have a Catholic renter coming onto our campus. Please welcome Dr. Mary Amore and the rest of the Mayslake Ministries affiliates.
