Dates - February 27 through April 2. The schedule is also on my website. Additional dates, if needed, will be added to the website calendar.

CLEARLY PRINT your full name on the score sheet. For changes fill out a registration form or email me a correction. It is your responsibility to be sure that I have your correct name and address.

Table Stakes \$0.25/\$0.50/\$0.75, double on the bump. To increase stakes all (3 or 4) players must agree.

Start Times – Be on time. The first session should start on time, the second based on completion of the first.

No Carry-Ins – Do not bring in your own, water, soda, alcohol, or food. If you are bringing in a treat or food, please get permission from the establishment's owner. Respect their business or we may lose a place to play.

Scoring – All players should monitor scoring. Don't be offended if someone points out a mistake. If seat one can score, it makes both the half way second side / score transfer and end of game tabulation more efficient, but should be adjusted to ensure accuracy. All players should monitor that correct scores are being logged. Assist the scorekeeper and don't be offended if someone points out a mistake. It is easy to get caught up in a conversation and miss a score or make a mistake. When you keep score, please total plays and score, allowing the Captain to double check. Two sets of eyes are better than one.

Playing With and Bringing NEW Players - EVERYONE is welcome – Support new players.

The paperwork has been upgraded again this year; updated documents are available on my website.

Snap a quick picture of both sides of your score sheet when you score 40 or higher.

Tentative final results will be on my website one week before I finalize and mail the checks out. Checks not cashed within 60 days will become void and you will lose your payback.

Entry fee is \$7.00 per session -- \$6.50 entry, \$0.25 captain's fee, \$0.25 hall rent, & bumps \$0.25.

Table and seat positions should be by luck of the draw, and table stakes are \$0.25/\$0.50/\$0.75, double on the bump. Table stakes can be increased, but the best way to scare people away is to bully them into doing something they don't want to do.
