

#### FEELING UNWELL

If a child attends school but is feeling unwell, has a cough, a runny nose or a temperature then we will call home.



Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell before leaving home.

## **Positive COVID19 cases**

Any student who has tested positive for COVID-19 will be required to isolate for seven full days. (7 days)

After the seven days of isolation the student is free to return to normal activities, if they are not symptomatic.

This is the same for students in a confirmed positive household case.
