This song is right out of the words of Psalm 63.3-4. Here are the first four verses of that song. O God, you are my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You in a dry and



You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You in a dry and thirsty land where there is no water. ²So I have looked for You in the sanctuary, to see Your power and Your glory. ³Because Your lovingkindness *is* better than life, my lips shall praise *You*. ⁴Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name.

Lloyd Oglivie gives us this explanation of this Psalm. **David's worship** is based on God's *"lovingkindness"* which is a greater good than *"life"* itself. This *"lovingkindness"* is His "grace," His "covenantlove," which finds David and holds him unconditionally. To be loved by God in this way is *"better than life,"* or to put it another way, it is to begin to live. ¹ It is my desire that each of us will experience the joy of knowing God's loving kindness that he lavishly gives us. What this world desires to give us pales in comparison to that amazing love. As you go about your days, continue to ponder the

many ways that God has given to you his unconditional, self-less, sacrificial love. When you do, you might find yourself lifting up your hands in praise to him.
