

LITURGY CORNER**October 9 - TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME****October 11 - Saint John XXIII, Pope****October 14 - Saint Callistus I, Pope and Martyr****October 15 - Saint Teresa of Jesus, Virgin and Doctor of the Church**

**Saint John XXIII** born in Italy in 1881, he was elected Pope in 1958 at the age of seventy-eight; he convened the Second Vatican Council on October 11, 1962; he died in 1963; he was canonized, together with Pope John Paul II, by Pope Francis on April 27, 2014. He wrote, *"A free heart and a pure intention give birth to generous love, which is the soul of every virtue and the strength of every sacrifice."* MAGNIFICAT

**Saint Callistus** ascended to the Chair of Peter around the year 217; he organized the first official Christian cemetery in Rome, which is perhaps the best-known repository of the remains of the early martyrs; he was crowned with martyrdom in the year 222. MAGNIFICAT

**Saint Teresa of Avila**, Spanish mystic who, with St. John of the Cross, reformed the Carmelite Order, creating the precise conditions that would renew the prayer of her fellow Carmelites: silence, austerity, and enclosure. She died in 1582 and in 1970 was the first woman declared Doctor of the Church.

TODAY'S READINGS

**First Reading** — Naaman, cleansed from his leprosy, returns to Elisha and pledges his belief in and allegiance to the LORD (2 Kings 5:14-17).

**Psalm** — The Lord has revealed to the nations his saving power (Psalm 98).

**Second Reading** — Remember Jesus Christ, who was raised from the dead. If we persevere, we shall reign with him (2 Timothy 2:8-13).

**Gospel** — After ten lepers are cleansed by Jesus, only one, a Samaritan, returns to give him thanks (Luke 17:11-19).

**Brothers and Sisters,**

In our first reading today and our gospel we are introduced to two special people. Both have leprosy, both are Samaritans and both are cured of their condition through their faith. God's healing touch has changed their outward condition, but their grateful response is a sign of the change within, a mark of their true faith. Leprosy was considered a sign of deserved punishment for sin. Those who suffered from the disease were believed to be morally and ritually unclean. Regardless of the severity of their disease they were cut off from society. In order to be restored to the community, they had to be healed, ritually cleaned, and officially pronounced clean. Jesus' healing action restores these two men and the other nine lepers to their rightful place in the community.



Faith is something much more than simply subscribing to a list of truths that we have to believe. It is at best a relationship, a relationship of love and trust that can transform life. Take Naaman the army commander, who appears in today's first reading. He was amazed at his miraculous cleansing from leprosy. Following the prophet Elisha's advice, he had plunged 7 times into the River Jordan. On coming out of the water found that he had been cured. Now, standing in front of the prophet, he makes an act of *faith* he said: "Now I know that there is no God in all the earth, except in Israel." When Elisha refuses to accept Naaman's gift he makes a strange request. Naaman says: "If you will not accept, please let me, your servant, have two mule loads of earth, for I will no longer offer holocaust or sacrifice to any other god except to the Lord." So why would Naaman make such a request? In ancient times there existed a belief that the power of gods was limited to their geographical area. He had been cured in Israel and he wanted enough soil to be able to worship and praise the Lord on soil from the land of his healing.

If faith leads to praise, we need go no further than today's gospel to learn that faith also leads to gratitude. As Jesus travels towards Jerusalem, he encounters 10 lepers and they cry out to him saying, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" He tells them to "go show yourselves to the priests", and on the way they realize they have been healed. However, of the 10, only 1 returns to Jesus to give him thanks and praise. He too is a Samaritan, a foreigner in the eyes of law-abiding Jews. Jesus with these words "Stand up and go; your faith has healed you." Sending him on his journey of life healed.

In one of his letters, St. Paul declares, "what matters is faith that makes its power felt through love." As we have seen, faith expresses itself in many ways-not only in love, but also in praise, in gratitude, and as we have heard in many scripture readings, unbelievable courage and fortitude. Perhaps we underestimate the power of faith in our lives; maybe we fail to see that faith is a relationship between God and ourselves, and that like any other relationship, it can grow stronger if that's what we truly desire.





### RESPONDIENDO A NUESTRAS BENDICIONES

Las lecturas de este domingo exploran cómo vemos y respondemos a la bendición en nuestras vidas. Escuchamos dos historias de curación y de agradecimiento, la del poderoso líder militar Naamán y la de un leproso samaritano sin poder. Ambos son ejemplos de humildad y gratitud que marcan la presencia de la fe en Dios. Observamos que tanto Naamán como el leproso vieron ampliados sus horizontes gracias a su curación. Una vez curados, no se limitaron a atribuirlo a un golpe de suerte y a seguir con sus vidas. Por el contrario, empezaron a ver a Dios en movimiento, llegando a todo el mundo, y bendiciendo activamente a toda la creación. Jesús señaló que la fe del leproso lo salvó, porque fue receptivo a ver esta realidad más completa. La fe cambia nuestra percepción. La fe nos permite ver más allá de nuestros límites habituales, abrazar a un Dios amoroso y participar en el reparto de ese amor con los demás.

San Lucas tiene un interés especial por los samaritanos. En Lucas y en los Hechos, los samaritanos aparecen continuamente, tanto en la parábola como en la narración. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús viaja entre pueblos con una larga historia de hostilidades entre los leales al Templo de Jerusalén y los que lo rechazaban (los samaritanos). Compartían muchas creencias comunes, y honraban al Dios de Abraham y de Moisés. Como en muchos conflictos, dos grupos que tienen mucho en común tienen trágicamente los desacuerdos más intensos.

El leproso samaritano regresó para agradecer a Jesús y alabar a Dios por su curación. Alguien que atravesaba la brecha social se convirtió en un ejemplo de fe en Dios, al igual que, anteriormente en Lucas, el buen samaritano demostró el amor al prójimo. ¿Podrías formar parte de un grupo que encuentra razones para desconfiar de otro grupo? Jesús apunta a nuevas posibilidades dentro y entre familias, etnias y grupos religiosos. Si "el otro" es de hecho admirable, si podemos aprender de él, entonces quizás podamos trabajar para reconciliarnos con él.

#### LOS CAMINOS DE DIOS

El pasaje de 2 Reyes concluye con la historia de Naamán, un líder militar extranjero que padece una enfermedad de la piel llamada lepra. Merece la pena leer la historia completa de Naamán, que comienza en 2 Reyes 5:1, ya que describe el viaje de un hombre poderoso desesperado por una cura, y que la encuentra de la forma más inesperada. Ha agotado todas las opciones disponibles para los ricos y bien conectados. Pero su esclava de Israel le señala a Eliseo, el poco conocido profeta judío. Otros siervos rescatan a Naamán de su orgullo, y éste es llevado a aceptar la curación.

Esta historia ilustra cómo los caminos de Dios son diferentes de los mundanos. Dios actúa principalmente a través de los humildes y los fieles, aunque el poder y la riqueza no resuelven el problema del mundo. Los marginados, o los humildes, suelen ser los más capaces de ver las oportunidades que Dios pone a su disposición. Cuando Naamán se humilló, descubrió los caminos de Dios y le dio gracias.

**San Juan XXIII** nació en Italia en 1881, fue elegido Papa en 1958 a la edad de setenta y ocho años; convocó el Concilio Vaticano II el 11 de octubre de 1962; murió en 1963; fue canonizado, junto con el Papa Juan Pablo II, por el Papa Francisco el 27 de abril de 2014. Escribió: "Un corazón libre y una intención pura hacen nacer el amor generoso, que es el alma de toda virtud y la fuerza de todo sacrificio." MAGNIFICAT

**San Calixto** ascendió a la Cátedra de Pedro hacia el año 217; organizó el primer cementerio cristiano oficial de Roma, que es quizás el depósito más conocido de los restos de los primeros mártires; fue coronado con el martirio en el año 222. MAGNIFICAT

**Santa Teresa de Ávila**, mística española que, con San Juan de la Cruz, reformó la Orden del Carmelo, creando las condiciones precisas que renovarían la oración de sus compañeros carmelitas: silencio, austeridad y clausura. Murió en 1582 y en 1970 fue la primera mujer declarada Doctora de la Iglesia.


