Question 1

Do you favor authorizing the School Board of Regional School Unit No. 57 (the "RSU") to issue bonds and other evidences of indebtedness in the name of the RSU in an amount not to exceed \$1,160,531 through the State of Maine's zero percent interest rate/loan forgiveness School Revolving Renovation Fund (SRRF) Program for structural roof improvements at Alfred Elementary School (the "Project")?

SRRF Program Funding. The Project costs (up to \$1,160,531) have been approved for funding through Maine's SRRF Program. Of this amount, the RSU will receive 40.97% (up to \$475,470) that will be forgiven, and 59.03% (up to \$685,061) that the RSU will repay at zero percent interest (0%) over a term of ten years.
