**Pony Equitation:** Open to rider who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday mounted on ponies. Small ponies jump 2', Medium Ponies jump 2'3", Large ponies jump 2'6".

**Limit Equitation:** Open to Junior and Amateur riders who have not won 6 or more blue ribbons at a recognized horse show. Fences set at 2'3"

**Open Equitation:** Open to all Junior and Amateur riders. Fences set at 2'6"

**Open Equitation:** Open to all Junior and Amateur rider. Fences set at 3'.

**RC Medal:** For complete specifications see show office. Fences set at 2'6".

**SWVHJA Adult Equitation:** Open to amateurs 18 years and older. To be show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF test 1 - 19 may be used.

**Fall Festival Hunter Derby:** Entry Fee: \$50. Open to all eligible riders. The order of go will be posted a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the start of the class. Horses entered in this class will NOT be required to jog for soundness. Any unsoundness during the competition will be reflected in the scores from the judge (GR 1031.7). Two round classes with fence heights of 2'6" and 3' to be judged together. Formal/dress attire required (per HU126). **Judging:** A maximum of 10 bonus points may be awarded by the judge to each horse/rider combination for handiness of round in Round 2. Numerical round scores and bonus points will be announced separately and will be combined for the total round 2 score. Round 1 and 2 scores will be combined to determine final placings. In the case of ties in the overall placings, the handy round score will be used to break any ties; there will NOT be a jump off for tied horses. **Round 1 Hunter Classic Course:** To be shown over a Hunter Classic type course consisting of a minimum of 10 fences/obstacles that simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and a variety of derby jumps will be used. Fence heights to be set at 2'6" and 3'. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality and substance, movement and brilliance. A minimum of (8) entries, including horses tied for 8th place, must return for Round 2, if available. Rider/horse combinations entered in 2'6" will show first, 3' combinations will show second. **Round 2 Handy Hunter Course:** Course will consist of a minimum of 8 obstacles and will include a minimum of two required "handy options." Rider/horse combinations will return in reverse score order with 3' combinations showing first and 2'6" to show second. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. **Prize Money:** Purse \$750; 1st: \$225, 2nd: \$165, 3rd: \$112, 4th: \$75, 5th: \$50, 6th: \$48, 7th: \$38, 8th: \$30

**SWVHJA Adult Medal:** Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pont Hunter division at the same horse show. Riders must stay within their age group if classes are split by age.

**SWVHJA Pony Medal:** Open to junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year.

**SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal:** Open to riders who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of this calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination, and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, may be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count for 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals a rider must accumulate 20 points during the show year. Four entries are required to fill the class. If there are fewer than four entries this class can be combined with the adult medal. After a rider has qualified for the finals, they may not compete in this class. Rider must be a member of SWVHJA.

**SWVHJA Jr. Equitation on the Flat:** Open to Juniors who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of December 1. To be show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF test 1 - 19 may be used.

**Oak Ridge Medal:** Open to junior and adult amateurs. Over fences phase will consist of a USET-type equitation and AO/JR jumper course of at least ten fences at 3' to 3'3" with spreads up to 4'. The course must include a triple combination or two double combinations. A Liverpool may be used, and a time allowed (345 yrs./min.) may be used in the first round. In the flat phase, competitors will show as a group at all working gaits and the working canter on the counter lead for at least one revolution of arena in both directions, but no more than 12 riders counter canter at one time. Flat phase counts for 50% and must be run first. At least the top ten riders from the flat phase will be called back for the second phase; jump order to be chosen by the judge. Over fences phase to count 50%. No martingales of any kind are permitted in the flat phase. Only properly fitted running martingales are permitted in the over fences phase. Same horse must be used in both phases; change of bridle permissible between phases. Gags and hackamores are permitted expect in flat phase. Correct attire is required. Judges may require additional testing (USEF tests 1-19).

### Directions

#### **From Charlottesville**

On route 29S, after you pass the last Amherst exit that the exit for Madison Heights/Sweet Briar College – This will be route 29 South Business. Heading on 29 South Business cross the James River and continue straight. DO NOT EXIT AT ANY BUSINESS ROUTE (460 or 501) OR AT CANDLERS MOUNTAIN RD/WARDS RD. Where 29 south makes a left exit, STAY STRAIGHT AND FOLLOW SIGNS FOR 501 NORTH. Turn left at the second stop light (501 North). Take the first exit which is Wiggington Road. Go right at the top of the ramp. Follow Wiggington Road to the end. You will see the Riding Center across the road. Turn right at the stop sign and the left into the parking lot next to the mailbox.

#### **From Roanoke (460 East)**

Take the third exit in Bedford to 221. At the bottom of the exit ramp turn left. Go a very short distance and take a right at the first road (Independence Blvd.). Follow Independence to the stop light and take a right on 221. Follow 221 into Lynchburg. Take a left at the stop light with the Honda dealership on the left (501 North). Turn left at the next stop light to continue on 501 North. Take the first exit (Wiggington Road). Follow Wiggington to the end, Riding Center will be across the road. Turn right at the stop sign and left into the parking lot next to the mailbox.

#### **From I-81 (Lexington)**

Take route 60 to Buena Vista. In Buena Vista take 501 South. In Snowden 501 South makes a right turn across the James River. Continue following the signs for 501 South. As you approach Lynchburg you will pass Eagle Eyrie on your left. After this, look for Mitchell's store and gas station. You will make a right onto Coffee Road just past Mitchell's. Take the second left off Coffee Rd. onto Hawkins Mill Rd. Go to the top of the hill and the riding center will be on your right. Turn in to the parking lot next to the mailbox.
