Information for Prospective Members:

Las Trampas Pool, Inc. is a non-profit California corporation made up of two hundred member families sharing ownership of the swim club. The facilities consist of a six lane x 25 yard pool swimming pool, small wading pool, pool deck and grounds, restrooms, office, and parking lot. The purpose of the corporation is to operate and maintain the club and its related recreational and social activities for use by its members.. A board of directors selected by the member's runs the corporation.

Cost of Membership: A one-time membership fee of \$675.00 is required. \$325 may be refunded at the sale of membership, \$350 is kept for administrative fees. Annual dues must be paid every year. Annual dues are determined by the Pool Board and currently are set at \$900.00 per year, plus a \$50 cleaning deposit that is refunded upon participation in Spring or Fall pool maintenance days.

Becoming a Member:

The first step toward becoming a member is to complete and submit this form. You may submit the form online by clicking [HERE](#). Once your form is submitted, you will receive an electronic invoice to pay the \$50 application fee. You can also opt to print and complete this form and mail with a check to our post office box address. Make your check payable to Las Trampas Pool, Inc. Please note this fee is non-refundable and may not be applied as credit for other fees. Upon receipt of your request and fee, we will send you a confirmation by e-mail that also indicates your family's position on our waiting list. Forty "Associate Memberships" are granted to families that have progressed through the waiting list. These Associate Members enjoy the same benefits as Full Members, but are not granted voting rights. Associate Members are considered "members-in-waiting" who are required to pay the initiation fee of \$675.00 as well as the annual dues .

Hours and Policies: Las Trampas Pool opens near the beginning of May and operates through September. Normal operating hours are from 3:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. weekdays and 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on weekends until school is out. Summer hours are generally daily from noon to 8PM. Adult swim periods are called quarter to the hour and last 15 minutes. Swim lessons for all levels of proficiency may be available during the season. Members may bring guests to the club. A guest is anyone over the age of three and in swim attire. Members will pay \$3.00 per guest. A complete policy handbook can be found on the Pool's website (www.lastrampaspool.com).

Seahorse Swim Team: Las Trampas Pool operates a recreational youth swim team called the Las Trampas Seahorses. The team is professionally coached and is overseen by a volunteer committee of pool members. Swim team participants learn swimming skills, have fun, and compete against other nearby youth swim teams. Emphasis placed on individual improvement, teamwork, and sportsmanship. The team is open to all members and associate members ages 4 thru 18. We also offer a Mudskippers program for younger and beginning swimmers. Children must be water-safe and able to swim the length of the pool to join the swim team.
