Meet in the front Parking area, bring a chair and a drink of choice.

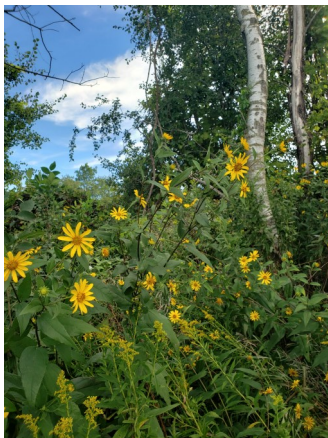


Slider cards will be provided. Each participant gets one (FREE) card and prizes for the winners will once again be provided by the
