

Clover Grove Horse Show COVID PROCEDURES

THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT ANY TIME.

General/Horse Show Grounds:

- FACE MASKS MUST BE WORN BY ALL PARTIES AT ALL TIMES WHEN UNMOUNTED AND WITHIN 6-FOOT DISTANCE TO ONE ANOTHER WHEN ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- Anyone entering the show grounds both on competition days and schooling days will be subject to a temperature check. Anyone with a temperature above 99.5 will not be permitted onto the grounds.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided around the show grounds, please maintain regular hand washing and hand sanitizing practices.
- Please be courteous and maintain 6-foot social distance at all times (this is equivalent to a landing or take off to a jump...or two people steps).
- Unless you are a Clover Grove employee, client or are stabled overnight, please do not enter the barn for any reason.
- The office can be accessed through the main entrance only.
- The outside wash areas is available to exhibitors only, they are beside the indoor and 4 stall shed row barn
- Porta Johns will be equipped with hand sanitizer and disinfecting supplies. It will be up to each user to disinfect surfaces prior to use.
- Concessions will not be provided on the show grounds. Please arrive equipped with sufficient food and water.
- Exhibitors may arrive no earlier than 1 hour prior to the start of their class and must depart from the show ground no later than 1 hour after the conclusion of their last class.
- We request that exhibitors exercise extreme caution when inviting friends, family and other guests to spectate. Please respect that for the time being we are attempting to reduce unnecessary traffic as we resume competition in our sport.

Entries/Show Office:

- MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN IN THE SHOW OFFICE.
- One representative per barn will be allowed into the horse show office prior to the competition to leave open checks and receive back numbers and after the competition to close the entries.
- No more than one exhibitor/trainer may enter the show office at any time.
- The horse show office must be accessed through the front door of the barn only.
- Please wait in line outside the show office, maintaining 6-foot social distancing – that would be equivalent to a take off or landing to a jump.
- All horses must be pre-entered ONLINE 1 days prior to the start of competition.
- PAPER ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- We encourage you to keep Back numbers throughout the 2 show series.
- All exhibitors must sign the WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT prior to receiving back numbers. This will be part of the online entry.
- Add/Scratching may be done online up until 6:00 AM on the day of competition.
- If you need to scratch, please be sure to do it online so as to maintain accuracy of the posted order. Entries that are not scratched online 24 hours prior to the start of competition will be assessed a \$25 scratch fee.

Checking In/Order of Go/In – Gate:

- MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN IN THE IN-GATE AREA UNLESS MOUNTED.
- Social distancing of 6-feet must be maintained at all times (again – same as landing or take off distance to a jump).
- There will be posted orders of go issued the day prior to competition. They can be found on the Clover Grove FaceBook page. Posted orders can also be found with the course charts.
- The In-Gate Area will be restricted to riders, trainers and grooms only.
- Loitering will not be permitted in the in and out gate areas.
- Courses will be posted both at the in-gate and the schooling area. They will also be available on FaceBook.
- We ask trainers and exhibitors to be conscious of the schedule and ensure that they arrive with their riders to the ring on time so that we can maintain the schedule throughout the day to the best of our ability for our all of our exhibitors.

Schooling Area:

- MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN IN THE SCHOOLING AREA UNLESS MOUNTED.
- Social distancing of 6-feet must be maintained at all times (again – same as landing or take off distance to a jump).
- Riders, trainers and grooms only are permitted in this area.
- Only the next 2 horses will be allowed in the schooling area at any given time.
- Riders, trainers and grooms only are permitted in this area.
- 1 person per jump are allowed in the schooling area at any given time – that is a total of 2 people.
- Hand sanitizer must be used prior to jump adjustment and after jump adjustment. Hand sanitizer will be provided for you at the entrance to the schooling area.
- Schooling will be available the day before the show in a ticketed style format from 12:00 to 7:00 PM. We request that trainers and exhibitors refrain from adjusting the jumps. 6 horses will be allowed in the ring at one time. The following height schedule will be adhered to:
 - Friday Prior to Competition
 - 12:00 - 3:00 fence height 2'6"
 - 3:00 Drag
 - 3:00 - 4:30 fence height 3'
 - 4:30 Drag
 - 5:00 - 7:00 Fence Height 2'3"
 - Saturday Morning of Competition
 - 6:30 am – 7:30 am schooling at fence height 2'6"
 - Saturday at the conclusion of the show
 - One hour of schooling at fence height 2'
 - Sunday Morning of Competition
 - 6:30 am – 7:30 am schooling over cross-rails only

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
