

Easter. Peeps, chocolate bunnies, egg hunts, Reese's eggs, elaborate productions, fancy clothes, baskets full of toys and candy, family portraits. Our family has many traditions and I know yours probably does too. These are all good things and I hope you get to take part in each of them. I sometimes wonder how they were able to even have that first Easter without any of these things. As much as we enjoy our traditions, I cannot imagine the joy and wonder and excitement of that first Easter! Can we emulate some of that excitement this year? Not because of the joy of watching the kids, or being inspired by the music or the productions, but because we remember how that

first Easter changed everything. It did, you know. It changed the future of each person who has ever lived. Some may deny it, some may not even know it, but it changed how everyone is called to live. As I read through the 24th chapter of Luke in preparation for this special day on the calendar, one verse stood out to me. One that we don't often associate with the story of Cleopas and his travelling companion. It is verse 34. It says simply, "It is true! The Lord has risen and has appeared to Simon." It is true!
