Saint Jerome Emiliani in the Church's art, he is with a ball and chain with which he was fettered as a prisoner of war in Italy in 1508. From the dungeon he asked Mary for help, and he escaped soon after. He eventually returned to his native Venice, where he was a helper and father to orphans and abandoned children; he died in 1537.

Saint Josephine Bakhita kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery, she endured great cruelty from a succession of masters until she landed in the service of an Italian family and experienced kindness that she hardly knew existed; she died in 1947; in 1993, Pope John Paul II brought her relics to Sudan, proclaiming, "*Rejoice, all of Africa, Bakhita has come back to you: the daughter of Sudan, sold into slavery as a living piece of merchandise, and yet still free: free with the freedom of the saints.*" In 2000, she was canonized, the first Sudanese saint as a witness to evangelical reconciliation and a model of freedom.

Saint Scholastica twin sister of St. Benedict, she died in 543. St Gregory the Great wrote, "*so death did not separate the bodies of these two, whose minds had ever been united in the Lord*".

Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11, 1858, a beautiful woman appeared to Bernadette Soubirous in a remote stone grotto outside Lourdes France. When asked her name, she replied, "*I am the Immaculate Conception.*" In the spot where she requested a chapel, a spring bubbled forth.



"The spring that Mary pointed out to Bernadette in Lourdes is the humble sign of this spiritual reality. From her believing heart, from her maternal heart, flows living water which purifies and heals". -Pope Benedict XVI

My Brothers and Sisters,

Faith is an adventure. God calls each of us to greatness. We may not feel worthy of such a calling, but this is normal. That is the message of today's readings. God will bless us in unimaginable ways, if we choose to believe. Isaiah, Paul and Simon Peter all felt unworthy when called by the Lord. Each of us is called to discipleship by Jesus as well.

We have all experienced great days when we feel we could accomplish anything. Athletes might say they feel in the zone. But what if God were to visit you and call you to serve on your worst day? How would you respond then? In our first reading, Isaiah the prophet while preaching in Jerusalem receives a terrifying vision of God. He knows himself to be a sinner and feels himself unworthy until a seraphim purifies his lips with a burning coal. Only then can he answer God's call: "Who shall I send? Who will go for us?" Isaiah responds with the words: "Here I am, send me!"

Paul, to whom the resurrected Jesus appeared, also felt unworthy, calling himself "the least of the apostles, not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God." By God's grace, he changed from persecuting the church to becoming its biggest promoter among the Gentiles. Paul knows himself to be a sinner and describes his transformation as being out of the normal course of things.

Commercial fishing is not for the faint of heart. Workers on commercial fishing boats remain at sea for weeks at a time. Such fishing is number one on the world's list of deadly occupations. Fatalities at sea are far higher than other dangerous occupations such as military service or service in law enforcement or fire suppression. Rogue waves are known to sweep people off decks and decks of modern vessels are full of hazardous machinery.

Fishing has always been a dangerous occupation. It certainly was in Simon Peter's time. The Sea of Galilee is actually a lake, the Lake of Gennesaret. The lake is eight miles wide and up to 150 feet deep. Squalls could come up without warning and capsize boats. Simon Peter and his crew had fished all night and caught nothing. They were cleaning their nets when Jesus, after teaching from Simon's boat suggested they go fishing again with him, further out. Simon and his men were ready for bed. They had worked at night because during the day the fish could see the nets. We can imagine the reluctance with which Simon and his crew set out again. Then Jesus tells them to "lower your nets for a catch". When they did, their boat and another as well almost sank because the catch was so great. Peter (still called Simon at the time) is amazed by Jesus' gracious help just as Isaiah was overwhelmed by God's blinding glory. Suddenly aware he is in the presence of God, Peter (Simon) like Isaiah recognizes he is not ready for this meeting uttering the words, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." After all, how many of us would like to meet our savior after failing at our day job? Jesus in turn tells them, "DO not be afraid."

Many people expect little from life, convinced that they are unlovable or beyond redemption. Jesus calls us to "put out into deep water," to trust that God really does love us. Faith, like seafaring, is a kind of venturing out and we can't let fear hold us back.



Seeking Qualified and Faithful Candidates to Serve on the Parish Finance Council

The revised Code of Canon Law, promulgated in November of 1983 states in Canon 537 "Each parish is to have a finance council which is regulated by universal law as well as by norms issued by the diocesan bishop; in this council the Christian faithful, selected according to the same norms aid the pastor in the administration of parish goods with due regard for the prescription of Canon 532."

St. Catherine of Alexandria is currently seeking a limited number of well-formed men and women of the Parish community to serve voluntarily on its Finance Council. The Parish's Finance Council is a collaborative body of qualified parishioners who are selected by the Pastor to advise him on financial and other business matters of the parish. It is a consultative council.

Qualified candidates should be a registered parishioner and have significant and broad experience in such areas as finance, accounting, management (small or large organizations), construction, facilities management, and fund raising. A practicing Catholic in good standing, who participates fully in the worship and life of the Church.

The Finance Council meets quarterly for 2-3 hours, and on occasion with the Pastoral Council and School Board. Members will need to attend a one-day Diocesan training seminar (when selected).

If you or someone you know feels that they are qualified and would like to be considered for this important ministry, please submit a resumé along with a short letter describing how you can faithfully serve as a member of the Finance Council. **Please submit these documents to Father Jun at stcofa@stcofa.org by February 14th.**





COMPARTIR LOS DONES DE DIOS

¿No es reconfortante saber que otros tienen problemas de baja autoestima? Hoy Isaías se llama así mismo un hombre con "labios impuros". Pablo "no es apto para ser llamado apóstol". Simón Pedro le dice a Jesús (quizá innecesariamente) "soy un hombre pecador". Todo esto puede ser cierto, pero Dios eligió a estos tres -impuros, no aptos, pecadores- como mensajeros importantes y esenciales en la obra de la salvación. Todos podemos recordar esto cada vez que tengamos la tentación de vernos como no aptos para (o excusarnos de) compartir la Buena Nueva. Tener una baja opinión de nosotros mismos no es humildad. A decir verdad, es una especie de arrogancia pensar que Dios no puede actuar a través de nosotros. Es bueno ser conscientes y honestos sobre nuestros fallos o limitaciones, pero también damos gloria a Dios reconociendo lo que somos capaces de hacer, compartiendo los dones que Dios nos ha concedido.

RECIBIR EL LLAMADO

Las lecturas de hoy presentan lo que se conoce como historias del "llamado" de personajes famosos de nuestra fe: Isaías, Pablo y Simón Pedro. Cada una de las historias comparte características comunes a la historia del "llamado" de las Escrituras: en primer lugar, un encuentro con Dios o con un mensajero de Dios. En segundo lugar, hay algún tipo de resistencia, normalmente enmarcada en una afirmación de indignidad. En tercer lugar, la persona que ha sido llamada recibe la seguridad de que, efectivamente, es apta para la misión. De este modo, Dios ha seguido llamando a profetas, apóstoles, santos, hombres y mujeres comunes a lo largo del tiempo. Es poco probable que alguno de nosotros reciba un "llamado" tan dramático como la de unos ángeles ardientes en el templo, una voz atronadora desde el cielo que nos golpee, o el sentarse codo con codo en una barca con Jesús de Nazaret. Esto no significa que no podamos, o no queramos, o no hayamos recibido una llamada de Dios. Incluso puede ser un "desprendimiento" de la de otra persona, de la manera en que Santiago y Juan son llamados a través de Jesús que le da a Simón Pedro su misión.

HOMBRE PECADOR, HOMBRE SANTO

Es probable que nos identifiquemos con Simón Pedro que, en el pasaje del Evangelio de hoy, está teniendo un mal día en el trabajo. Cuando tu trabajo es pescar y no pescar, es un mal día. Para colmo, sabe que está en presencia de un hombre santo en la persona de este Jesús de Nazaret, que acaba de requisar su barca para hacer una predicación espontánea. Por muy buena que haya sido la predicación, seguramente no puso peces en las redes. Así que, como hará a lo largo del Evangelio, Jesús rectifica la situación. Simón Pedro sabe que no está simplemente en presencia de un hombre santo, sino de la santidad misma, y declara su pecaminosidad. Sin embargo, se le encarga la obra del Evangelio. No importa lo mal que nos vaya el día, o lo incompetentes que nos creamos, estamos recibiendo el llamado. ¿Nuestro papel en la historia? Escuchar.

11 de febrero - Bienaventurada Virgen María de Lourdes

San Jerónimo Emiliani en el arte de la Iglesia, está con una bola y una cadena con las que fue encadenado como prisionero de guerra en Italia en 1508. Desde el calabozo pidió ayuda a María, y escapó poco después. Finalmente regresó a su Venecia natal, donde fue ayudante y padre de huérfanos y niños abandonados; murió en 1537.

Santa Josefina Bakhita secuestrada de niña y vendida como esclava, soportó una gran crueldad por parte de una sucesión de amos hasta que cayó al servicio de una familia italiana y experimentó una bondad que apenas sabía que existía; murió en 1947; en 1993, el Papa Juan Pablo II llevó sus reliquias a Sudán, proclamando: "Alegraos, toda África, Bakhita ha vuelto a vosotros: la hija de Sudán, vendida como mercancía viva, y sin embargo libre: libre con la libertad de los santos". En el año 2000 fue canonizada, la primera santa sudanesa, como testigo de la reconciliación evangélica y modelo de libertad.

Santa Escolástica, hermana gemela de San Benito, murió en 543. San Gregorio Magno escribió: "así la muerte no separó los cuerpos de estas dos, cuyas mentes habían estado siempre unidas en el Señor".

Nuestra Señora de Lourdes el 11 de febrero de 1858, una hermosa mujer se le apareció a Bernadette Soubirous en una remota gruta de piedra en las afueras de Lourdes Francia. Cuando le preguntaron su nombre, respondió: "Soy la Inmaculada Concepción". En el lugar donde pidió una capilla, brotó un manantial.

"El manantial que María señaló a Bernadette en Lourdes es el humilde signo de esta realidad espiritual. De su corazón creyente, de su corazón materno, brota el agua viva que purifica y cura".


