- 12.1 Partners for Climate Protection (PCP) Program Municipal Action <u>Plan 2020-2025 – Briana Cowie, Eastern Charlotte Waterways Inc.</u> Briana Cowie of ECW updated Council on the draft Municipal Action Plan 2020-2025, advising they are at the stage of the plan for Community Engagement, where the draft plan is made available for public comment/feedback. Matthew Hall of Blacks Harbour gave a presentation to Council and submitted a petition requesting Council consider amending Rural Plan Bylaw Z.1 – section 26.2(a) to allow the keeping of urban chickens. Petitioners are seeking to be able to raise up to 6 egg laying hens (with the exception of male roosters) in an enclosed pen/coop and ask that Council consider adopting a similar by-law as other communities have in Charlotte County.

Mayor James advised Council would take the request under consideration and if Council so chooses, they can make an amendment under our Rural Plan By-law, noting the process takes several months to complete.

Community contacts noted: complaints regarding duck hunters, ice buildup on Gaudett's Lane and several areas of Wellington Road, abandoned boats and scows in Wellington on shore, abandoned vehicle left on Main Street lawn all winter with windows down.
