### I THESSALONIANS

Part Twenty Three: "What Every Believer Should Do For Every Other Believer"

#### I Thessalonians 3:1-2

Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone; And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:

#### Paul Sent Timothy from Athens to Thessalonica

- 1. The <u>need</u> for Timothy's mission:
  - a. Paul couldn't wait any longer to know how they were doing.
  - b. Paul had to finish what he had begun in Athens.
- 2. Timothy's <u>qualifications</u> for the mission:
  - a. "Brother" he had the same Christian spirit as Paul
  - b. "Minister of God" he was called of God
  - c. "Fellowlabourer" he was a faithful worker
- 3. The <u>purpose</u> of Timothy's mission:
  - a. Establish the people in their faith
  - b. Encourage the people in their faith

# Every believer ought to strive to do two things for every other believer:

- 1) <u>Strengthen</u> them in their faith.
- 2) Encourage them in their faith.
