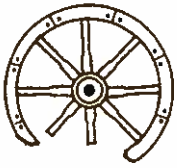


The Mayor and Council reconvened into open session.
