We have arrived!!! We landed in Shannon, Ireland on November 15. We were picked up at the airport by the Ledbetter family, who graciously opened their home to us until we were able to find a house to rent! The last month and a half since we have arrived has been crazy at times, but also many times of answered prayers on big events. As we finish getting settled in, we are eager to get more involved in the ministries of the church in the coming months.

On November 23, the Lord gave us a beautiful home to rent and it even comes with a spare room for visitors! Our new field address is: 58 Castle Avenue, Muskerry Estate, Ballincollig, Co. Cork, Ireland. We do still receive our mail that is sent to Word for the World.

Our landlord is also a gift from God as well and she has been doing so much to make our house very nice for us. Her name is Theresa O'Leary and she lived in the States for 13 years! She understands the differences in culture and has helped us with adapting to the Irish culture. We are praying that we have a good opportunity to witness to her and her family and that we will be the best tenants that she's ever had. We've already given her a tract, but are hoping to expound more of the Gospel with her soon.

On December 3 we received our passport stamps to remain in the country until November 14, 2013. We have to reapply every year. Thankfully there were no big issues to get our stamps and we truly believe it is because so many people were praying for our immigration process. We were also able to get an Irish bank account later that day, which was needed for so many things!

Then our container arrived from the States on December 13. We had several people from the church help us unload it. Praise the Lord that nothing was broken and customs released it with no problems at all!

On December 19 we had "Christmas on the Street", in which several church families came out to sing Christmas carols on the streets of Cork and to also hand out special Christmas tracts. There were nearly 1000 tracts handed out that day! Please pray that they will make an impact upon the people that read them and that many will be saved.

This last week we saw our first convert in the ministries here! A lady by the name of Nicola O'Callaghan had been coming to the Reformers Unanimous meetings and after a few weeks of hearing the Gospel message, she trusted Christ. Another missionary couple led her to Christ in her home and we are rejoicing at the news. She has since started coming to church on Sunday morning and Wednesday night. Please continue to pray for her as she grows in the Lord.

Thank you so much to those who sent us Christmas cards. They were a great blessing and encouragement to us! We had a blessed first Christmas in Ireland and praying we will have many more here if the Lord carries His coming! Have a happy New Year and thank you for your faithful prayers and support!
