Aim for Change:

- 1. **SUMMARIZE** the points of Paul's Gospel message
- 2. **BE CONFIDENT** in our ability to use Scripture to bring others to the knowledge of Christ
- 3. **IDENTIFY** ways we can tell resistant listeners about Christ

Devotional Reading:

- Thursday The Voice of Discipline Deuteronomy 4:32-40; Proverbs 3:11-12; 15:9-11; Hebrews 12:4-8
 - o Are you equipped to handle correction/rebuking without getting your feelings hurt?
 - o How has God revealed Himself to you? How have you heard His voice?
 - o Can you be disciplined to be a disciple without obedience?

Focal Verses:

- Sunday *Acts* 28:23-31 Teaching Boldy without Hindrance
 - o (vv. 23-25a) Paul Shares the Gospel with the Jews Luke 8:5-18; Acts 17:1-4; 26:22-23
 - Do you set a day aside to witness to others?
 - Do you let your lack of Bible knowledge hinder you from witnessing?
 - Why is it so difficult for others not to accept the Gospel of Christ through you?
 - (vv.25b-27) The Jews Turn Away Isaiah 6:9-10; Jeremiah 5:20-31; Romans 11:1-10
 - Are you easily discouraged when your witnessing is rejected?
 - Do you take that rejection personal? Does that rejection weaken your faith in Christ?
 - Where can you find strength to overcome discouragement/rejection?
 - o (vv. 28-31) Paul Preaches to the Gentiles Philippians 1:19-30; 1 John 3:1-10
 - Do you let distractions hinder your proclamation of the Gospel?
 - When you witness, do you witness with confidence or uncertainty?
 - How can your negative circumstances be used for positive witnessing?
