LOCAL PROFESSIONALISM PANEL/

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Supreme Court entered Administrative Order SC13-688, re: *Code for Resolving Professionalism Complaints*, which directed the Chief Judge of each circuit to create a local professionalism panel to receive, screen and act upon complaints of unprofessional conduct, and to resolve these complaints informally, if possible, or refer them to the Florida Bar, if necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order 2.074, *Establishment of Local Professionalism Panel*, sets forth the purpose and procedures of the panel, including the Chief Judge's authority to appoint the members of the panel, as well as the authority to appoint a chairperson;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to appoint a new chairperson, based on the retirement of County Judge Peary Fowler;

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Honorable Albert Kelley is appointed as Chairperson of the 16th Judicial Circuit's Local Professionalism Panel, replacing County Judge Peary Fowler.
2. The 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit's Local Professionalism Panel members are:

3. Due to the retirement of Judge Peary Fowler, a vacancy exists on the panel. Until such time a new member can be appointed, the panel is authorized to conduct business with three judicial members and five attorney members.
