Happy New Year! We have recently been in Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Florida. Our final missions conference of the year was our first with the mission board's president, Dr. David Snyder. It was such a joy to see him and his family, along with the other missionaries at the conference. We completed our 2014 year having presented in 61 churches. What a year it was! It was wonderful to be involved in nineteen missions conferences, two Vacation Bible Schools, two fair ministries, church soul-winning with multiple churches, and even a Christian camp, along with several other outreach opportunities. It is such a blessing to be able to see God working in hearts and working through us as we travel. We were also blessed to be able to spend time with family for Christmas. One of our highlights of the time at home was being able to minister to shut-ins and nursing home residents by making them cookies and handing out Gospel tracts. We are looking forward to many new adventures in the 2015 calendar year.

One of our first new adventures this year will be our second survey trip to Grenada. We will be embarking on that journey from February 7-21. We will be touching down on Grenada's Independence Day, so we are looking forward to partaking of the customary breadfruit oil-down, the national dish. During this trip, we plan to meet with each of the national pastors, praying for God's clear direction on which one to work with upon our arrival full-time. We also are hoping to finalize our plans on where to live initially. Another major goal that we have while on the Grenadian shores is for the finalization of Joseph's dual-citizenship. Please pray for our safety and for God's provision concerning the financial aspect of this travel. We are looking forward to the new experiences both there, and in our travels in the days ahead.

We are thankful for a new supporting church, bringing us to 45% of our support. Thank you for your constant prayers for our health and safety. God has truly shown Himself faithful to us this past year, and we are so excited to see Him provide for the future too! We are thankful also for a number of churches that have expressed interest in partnering with us financially. Please pray that God provides for them, that they may become new partners with us in our endeavor to reach Grenada.

Over the next two months, we will be in churches in New Jersey, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Maryland. Our prayer is that God will be glorified through the presentation of our ministry and the preaching of the Word of God. We would also like to ask for you to pray for one of our supporting pastors, Gary Wimberly, who just learned that he has stage 3 cancer. He has entered immediate treatment, but we would like to ask you to pray for God's healing touch upon his body. I am thankful we serve a powerful God! Please pray also for Brielle, who has been sick for several weeks with croup and now a cold. Please pray also that lives will be changed, and the lost will become new creatures as we continue on during the deputation journey.
