

Privacy Policy

Collection of your Personal Information

The Company collects only limited personally identifiable information, such as your name and e-mail address. The Company also may collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests, and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by the Company. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses.
