College Park Baptist Church 3435 Crill Avenue Palatka, FL 32177 Our Deacons have been evaluating the membership rolls of our church. They've been prayerfully addressing the fact that many former members have joined other churches, moved out of the area, become disinterested in attending anywhere, died, or have simply become unfindable.

Church membership is not only about identification. Joining a church is not like joining the health club or the rotary and seldom if ever participating in their activities. Joining the visible body of Christ is about participation. It's not about preserving family traditions or securing the use of the church facilities for weddings or other prominent family events.

The church is a body, and missing parts of the body create challenges for the parts that remain. As your interim pastor I have given considerable thought to how we might address the fact that our body has many missing parts.

- One solution is to improve the health of the body by the faithful teaching of God's Word that brings spiritual growth. I am seeking to do that by faithfully opening God's Word in our services.
- Another solution is to convey to the missing parts the value they potentially bring to the body. We've spent considerable time and energy seeking lost members, exhorting them to return.
- A last recourse is to be sure that our membership rolls reflect the reality of our church. Let me be clear, those who are unable to attend due to age or other infirmity need to be preserved as members in honor of their history with the church.

What are the consequences of keeping able but absent members on the rolls?

- First, keeping able members on the rolls who never attend church allows them to ignore God's Word. Hebrews 10:25 commands us to gather as a body. Failing to do so is more than a preferential choice, it is disobedience to God's Word.
- Second, chronically absent able members lose the opportunity for being taught God's Word, engaging in corporate prayer, finding supportive fellowship in their challenges, and observing communion that stimulates confession of sin.
- Third, when able members of the body are chronically absent, the work of the ministry is hindered for a lack of workers.
- Fourth, chronically absent able members deny church leaders the opportunity to give an account of those under their care as commanded in Hebrews 13:17. That text places accountability for the body squarely on its leaders.

As your leaders, we covet your prayers as we navigate the membership "waters" with a view to glorifying God and enhancing the visible body of Christ.
