# SWIMMING LESSONS

## FOR PRESCHOOL & UP

Weeks of September 1, 2020–May 27, 2021

**\$12 per week**

**\$25 registration fee due with application**

The Quentin Road Instructors use a skill based program referencing the YMCA and the American Red Cross as guidelines for our swimming lessons.

Class size is limited to 4 to 1 for Preschool, and 6 to 1 for Kindergarten and up. We have a minimum of 2 Lifeguard Certified Instructors and an additional Lifeguard at poolside at each lesson. If their swim lesson is during their scheduled school day, they will be accompanied to and from the pool area.

Swimming lessons will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

30 minute lessons [plus 15 minutes before and after lesson to change & shower—no time to wash and dry hair]

Tuesdays 1pm–3pm

Thursdays 1pm–4:15pm (3pm–4:15pm for Kind & Up only)

Children need to be potty trained.

Absentees are not eligible for refunds or make up lessons.

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# INTRO TO PIANO

## MUSIC FOR LITTLE MOZARTS

**FOR PRE-KINDERGARTEN & KINDERGARTEN (Limit 28)**

Level 1 kit includes: tote bag, Beethoven Bear, Mozart Mouse, lesson book, workbook, Discovery Book, 2CDs, flashcards, music activity board with 10 magnets, dry erase pen and eraser

Level 2 kit includes: tote bag, J.S. Bunny, Pachelbel Penguin, lesson book, workbook, Discovery Book, 2 CDs, flashcards, and stickers

Children will receive one on one instruction on the piano for 30 minutes each week. Music for Little Mozarts was written for the preschool and kindergarten age groups. This curriculum provides a balance between the discipline necessary for playing the piano and the enjoyment one receives from the process of music making. The course centers on the adventures of Beethoven Bear and Mozart Mouse as they learn about music. Three correlating books (Music Lesson Book, Music Workbook and Music Discovery Book) guide the children through a comprehensive approach to musical learning, using the piano throughout the school year. Absentees are not eligible for refunds.

Taekwondo is not only fun for kids, but also a great full-body exercise which increases strength, coordination and flexibility! Master Edgar Mosquera of Epic Martial Arts is a 6<sup>th</sup> degree black belt. Using age-appropriate games and drills, he will teach the children basic kicks, punches, blocks, forms, katas, stances, and board breaking. Using these skills, he will also be teaching character building. Respect is taught not by scaring them into submission, which is often mistaken as respect, but actual respect. Respect for the knowledge and skill that the instructors can teach, for their friends that they spar with, and for the school that they attend. Self-discipline is taught by teaching children to wait their turn to make a comment or wait to talk to a friend, and to be able to listen to someone who is teaching them instead of rolling their eyes or wandering off.

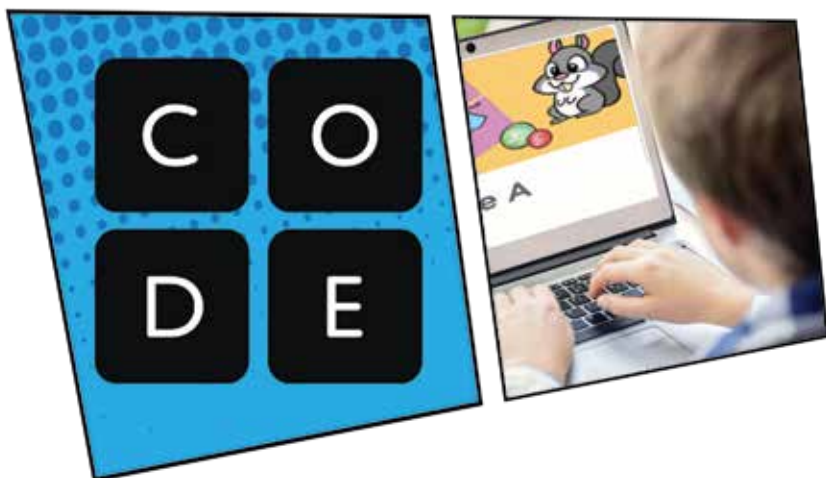

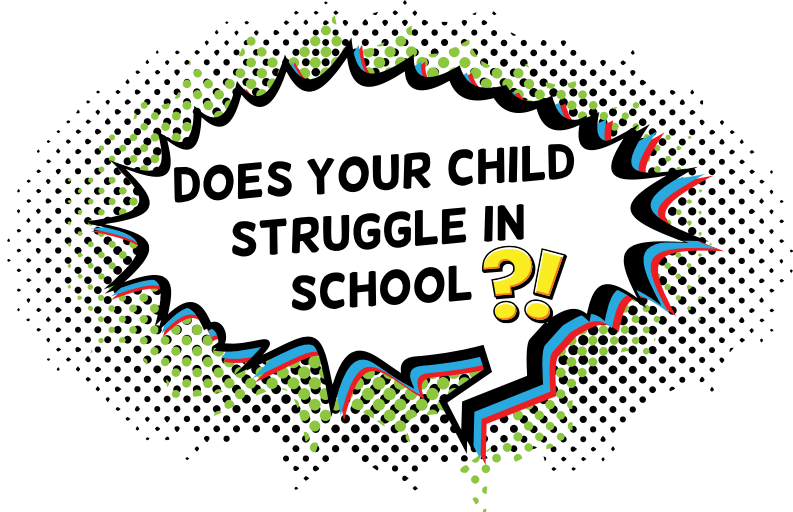

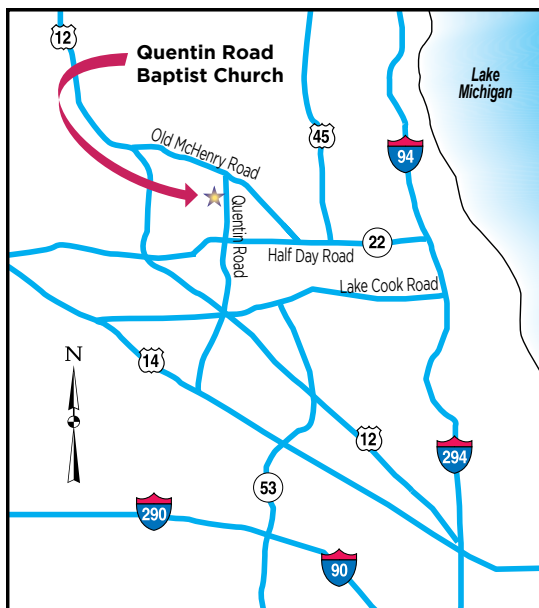
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
