I Thessalonians 1:6-7

And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost: So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia.

C. Transition of Influence. 6-7.

- 1. They <u>received</u> God's Word. 1:6b.
 - a. They paid a great price. In much affliction.
 - b. They enjoyed great blessings. With joy of the Holy Ghost.
- 2. They <u>submitted</u> to God's Leadership. 1:6a.
 - a. They followed God's men. Ye became followers of us.
 - b. They followed God Himself. And of the Lord.
- 3. They embodied God's Ways. 1:7.
 - a. Their influence was <u>iconic</u>. Ye were ensamples.
 - b. Their influence was <u>inspiring</u>. *To all that believe*.
 - c. Their influence was <u>infectious</u>. *In Macedonia and Achaia*.

GREAT TRUTHS
