- 500-800 weight feeder Steers and Heifers; Medium frame, Grades 1 and 2

Requirements:

- ➔ Weaned 30-45 days
 - ➔ Two (2) rounds of vaccines
 - At least one round must have been with a Modified Live vaccine. If two rounds of a killed vaccine have already been administered, please contact Dr. Matthews to get the Bovi-Shield Gold one shot vaccine.
 - ➔ Dewormed within 60 days of sale
 - ➔ Implanted or Non-Implanted
 - ➔ GUARANTEED open Heifers {a \$100 charge may apply later if the heifer is found to be bred}
 - ➔ No exotics (no excessive ear or dairy influences)

- Drop-off/Check-in will be MONDAY 9-3-18 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM
 - Calves not matching grade will have the option to be taken back by the seller or be sold as singles, mentioned as having 2 rounds of vaccines and weaned, immediately following the Load Lot Sale.
 - We are more than happy to come out and weigh and tag calves prior to the sale and/or deliver tags for the producer to put in prior to the sale

Lot 1: Comingled Group of 4 Local Cattle Producers

Head: 76 Heifers

Weight: 644 lbs avg.; 48958 lbs Total Weight {with 2% Shrink}

Origin: Shelby, NC and surrounding area

Description of Cattle: Cattle will be 80% #1's and 20% #1 1/2's. Cattle will be 62 Black or BWF, 4 Red or RWF (no Hereford), and 10 Charolais cross (no pink nose). No extra ear, no navel, and no horns.

Frame: Medium/Large

Flesh: Medium

Weight Spread: 115 lbs

Feed: Hand fed daily and on pasture

Delivery: Cattle are present at sale barn and will need to be picked up as soon as possible

Weighing: Cattle were brought in on Sept. 3, 2018, weighed and shrunk 2%. They were then placed on hay, water, and feed.

Vaccination: Two rounds of Bovishield Gold, two rounds of Vision 7 with somnus, and dewormed with Longrange or Cydectin.

Head: 72 Steers

Weight: 684 lbs avg.; 49255 lbs Total Weight {with 2% Shrink}

Origin: Shelby, NC and surrounding area

Description of Cattle: Cattle will be 85% #1's and 15% #1 1/2's. Cattle will be 63 Black or BWF, 6 Red or RWF (no Hereford), and 3 Charolais (no pink nose). No extra ear, no navel, and 2 with 3 inch horns (horns can be removed upon request).

Frame: Medium/Large

Flesh: Medium

Weight Spread: 150lbs

Feed: Hand fed daily and on pasture

Delivery: Cattle are present at sale barn and will need to be picked up as soon as possible

Weighing: Cattle were brought in on Sept. 3, 2018, weighed and shrunk 2%. They were then placed on hay, water, and feed.

Vaccination: Two rounds of Bovishield Gold, two rounds of Vision 7 with somnus, and dewormed with Longrange or Cydectin.
