We are also looking forward to what God is going to do this year as we continue to serve Him. He did not receive Christ that day, but he agreed to allow us to host a Christmas party at the government school in the village. We prepared Christmas cookies, a small notebook, and pencil for each of the students, and Christmas cookies, and Bible for each of the teachers present. I taught through the Christmas story in Luke 2, and preached the Gospel. The chief attended the party and we talked afterward. He really enjoyed the program and the truth that was presented. I am praying that the Lord will continue to work in his heart, and he will trust Christ alone for salvation.

We really enjoyed our first Christmas in Cameroon! Looking forward to many more years here! Thank you for all the extra gifts and notes that were sent during the month. Each one is a special blessing to us.
