**The Regular Meeting was called to order
Pledge of Allegiance was recited**

Present: Mayor Dianne Dubberly, Vice Mayor Barbara Thomas, Councilman Johnny Ho, Councilman Anthony Kelley, Councilman Sheila Dubberly, Councilman Jishnu Dasa Fitch, Accountant Choi Choi and Town Clerk Lee Forzly **Absent:** Attorney John Maines

Councilman Kelley made the motion to approve the minutes from the Regular Meeting (Zoom) on July 13,2020. Councilman Dubberly seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Vote carries unanimously.

Budget Report: Accountant Choi Y Choi

Choi reported all revenues and expenses were normal as usual for July 2020. Choi discussed the budget for the general fund in relation to the clerk hours. Based on the revenue projection from the state, we will not have a loss for the general fund. If the clerk works 15 hours, the general fund will have \$2,171 left. If the clerk works 12 hours, there will be a \$4,331.60 balance. At last, the council decided to keep the hours for the clerk at 15. This motion was approved by Councilman Thomas and seconded by Councilman Kelley. Motion carries unanimously

Deputy Assistant Chief Miller was there to present the information related to the repair of the Fire Engine. The total was \$1,500 and the service was made without council approval as it was essential to the operation. The repair was approved by Councilman S. Dubberly and seconded by Councilman Thomas. Motion carries unanimously.

Choi also discussed the purchase of computers for the 3 fire trucks. According to Chief Harris, Alachua no longer supports the software that we had for the dispatch radio system. Depends on the availability of refurbished units, it could cost between \$2,000 to \$6,000. Motion was approved for the purchase of 3 computers up to \$6,000. This motion was approved by Councilman Thomas and seconded by Councilman Kelly. Motion carries unanimously.

The cash balance for the General Fund \$61,301; Fire \$9,090; Street \$263,804 Money Market \$71,168; CD \$18,189 and WSPP \$59,603.

Springs County Presentation- Tim Marden and Michael Childers

There was a brief introduction for creating a new county called Springs County, formed from the western portions of Alachua County, and would include the Cities of; Alachua, Archer, Newberry, High Springs and LaCrosse. There was a brief discussion. No motion was made.

Fire Department: Fire Chief Buddy Harris, Assistant Fire Chief Leonard Reeder and Deputy Chief Chris Miller

- a. Call Report: Total EMS Calls – 41. Alachua County – 21, Lacrosse – 4, Town of Alachua - 9 , City of Gainesville – 7, and High Springs – 0, Brooker – 0, Worthington Springs – 0. Total Fire Calls -3. District 22 (Alachua County) -2, and Town of Alachua -1.

New Business:

1. Bridge Repair/Cleaning Proposal- Swamp Cutters

a. **Power Wash- \$300.00** Councilman Kelley made the motion to approve the \$300.00. Councilman Dubberly seconded the motion. After a brief discussion the vote carried unanimously.

b. **Remove debris- \$495.00-** Councilman Kelley made the motion to approve the \$495.00. Vice Mayor seconded the motion. After a brief discussion, the vote carried unanimously.

c. **Seal cracks - \$450.00.** Vice Mayor Thomas made the motion to approve the \$450.00. Councilman Kelley seconded the motion, after a brief discussion, the vote carries unanimously.

d. **Repair exposed rebar-** Councilman Kelley made the motion to approve the \$450.00. Councilman Dubberly seconded the motion. After a brief discussion, the vote carried unanimously.




