## Aim for Change:

- 1. How did "you" UNDERSTAND Paul's description of Jesus Christ's supremacy?
- 2. Do "you" **EXPRESS** feelings of amazement at the supremacy of Jesus Christ?
- 3. How do "<u>you</u>" **DESCRIBE** to others the awe-inspiring preeminence of Christ for bringing reconciliation?

## Devotional Reading: Monday – Christ, the Head of the Church – Ephesians 1:17-23; John 17:20-26; Romans 8:31-39; 1 Corinthians 12:12-17

- 1. How can you gain a better understanding of our Lord Jesus Christ?
- 2. Are you confident enough in your relationship with Jesus to not backslide?
- 3. If you knew Jesus prayed for you, would you still lack trust in Him?
- 4. Do you know what part of the body "*you*" are in the church? Do you act like it's more important than another part within the body?

## Focal Verses: Sunday - The Person and the Work of Christ - Colossians 1:15-20

- Christ Reigns Supreme in Creation (vv. 15-17) John 1:1-3, 14, 18; 1 Timothy 3:14-16; Hebrews 1:1-3
  - 1. Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature?
  - 2. What characteristics does Paul point out regarding Christ reigning supreme from creation?
  - 3. How do you report out on Jesus? How do you lift Him up?
- Christ Reigns Supreme in the Church (v. 18) 1 Corinthians 15:12-26; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
  - 1. What are some of the attributes of Jesus Christ?
  - 2. Explain the two definitions of "*firstborn*" and how Jesus fits them both?
  - 3. Who's the Head of the Church? How is it constructed?
  - 4. Is Christ the first to be resurrected?
  - 5. Do *you* truly believe in the resurrection?
- Christ Reigns Supreme in Redemption (vv. 19-20) Philippians 2:5-11
  - 1. What strong statements did Paul emphasize about Christ and His supremacy?
  - 2. How has Christ brought peace to the world? How has Christ brought peace to you?
  - 3. Are you truly reconciled?
