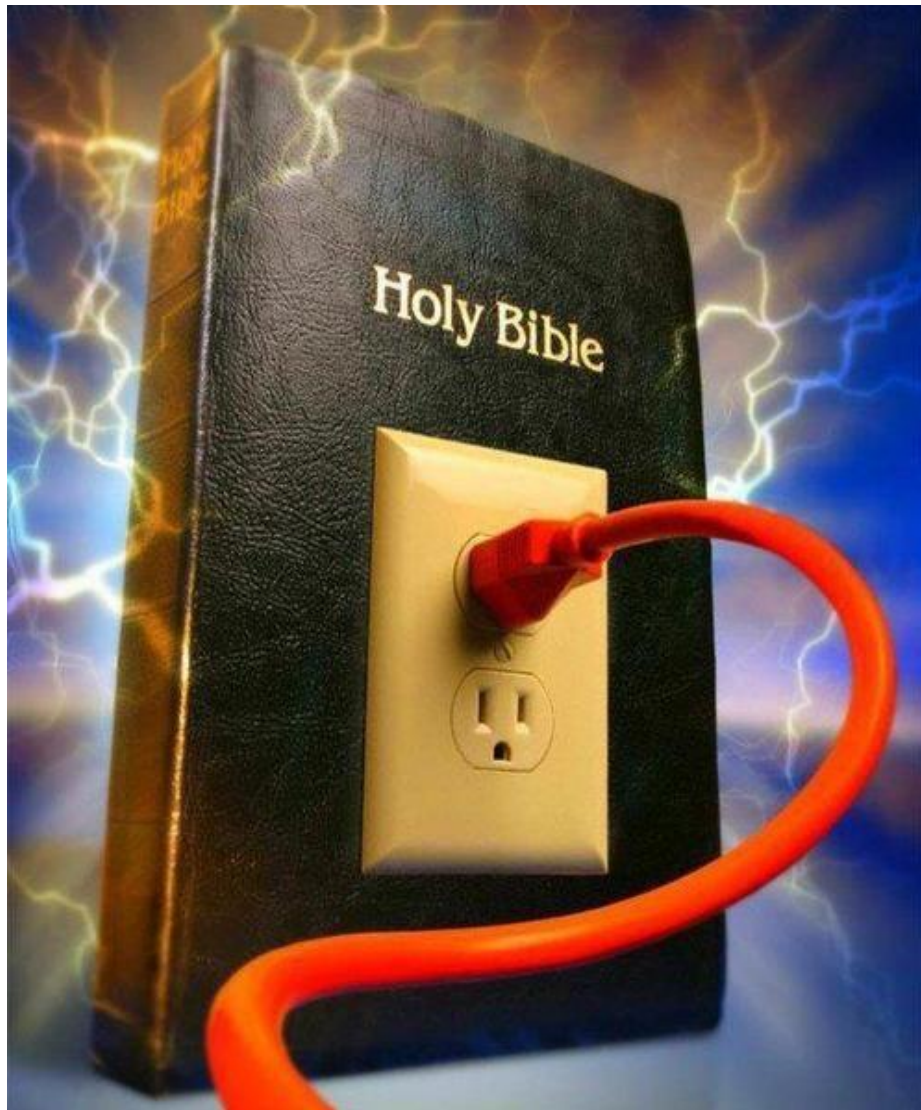

There are still lots of ways for you to participate. Prayer Team: Add PCMM to your daily prayer list. Phone Support: Answer the clinic calls remotely, provide basic information and send messages as needed. Receptionist: Greet patients. Eligibility Specialist: Become certified by the Health Department to complete eligibility paperwork. Office Support: Assist with patient data entry into the electronic medical record; assist with patient sign out procedures, other office needs. Medical Assistant / Nurse: Provide patient care triage and assist Provider as needed. Staff arrives at 3pm for set up. Come by, check it out and join in the mission.
