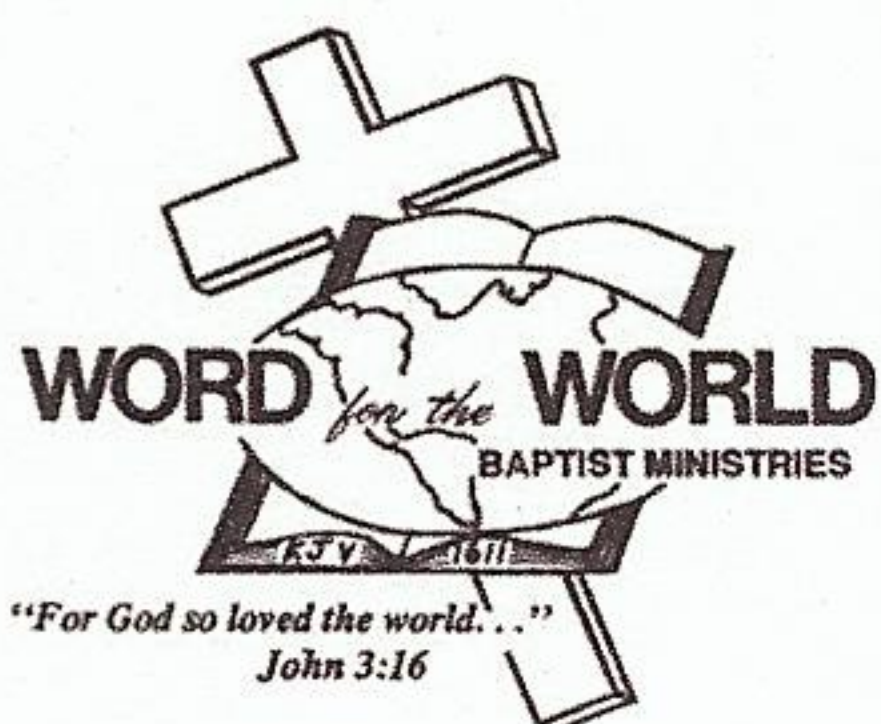

Dear Friends and Family,

Also since our last letter, we have been privileged to lead two souls to the Lord! The first was a young man named Joseph Kelly in Camden, Arkansas, in January. Then the next week we were able to lead a teenage girl in 10<sup>th</sup> grade named Katie Linsdowne to the Lord in Frederick, Maryland. It was very neat how Katie came to put her faith in Christ. We were out soul-winning in an apartment complex and as she was walking across the parking lot to throw away some garbage, Jennifer went over to hand her a tract and invite her to church. She then asked Katie if she attended a church. Katie said she attended a Tabernacle church, and when asked about if she knew she'd go to Heaven, she said she had no idea if she would be able to go. Jennifer asked her if she'd like to know, and brought her over to me, and I went through the Bible and showed her why Christ came and died on the old rugged Cross. She realized quickly that she was a sinner and that she was destined for Hell. Soon after, she bowed her head and trusted Christ as her Savior.
