
As the women's team continues to prepare for the walk, maybe you have a pilgrim God has placed in your thoughts. Now is the time to invite them and get their application filled out.

I believe the most important phrase in that run-on sentence is 'we want'. As I step back and take a long look at the circumstances around us, I realize we need to focus more on what God wants and less on what we want. We all know the first line of the 23rd Psalm, right?
