Duties (brief description and not limited to):

- Tends equipment units or semiautomatic system that processes chemical substances. Adds, via vacuum, specified amounts of solid and liquid materials into heating vessels or blending tanks; and turns valves to feed gaseous materials through equipment units.
- Turns valves or moves controls to maintain system at specified temperature, pressure, and vacuum levels.
- Observes chemical reactions and monitors gauges; and receives notification from control laboratory, supervisor, or other workers to make specified operating adjustments.
- Draws samples of products for laboratory analysis.
- Maintains log of gauge readings and shift production.
- Maintains equipment within work area.
- Maintains clean work area.
