Battles. Do you have battles?

Better question, who doesn't have battles? We all have battles. Life is a battle. Sometimes it feels like we're losing every battle. Battles with health, relationships, finances, addictions, you name it. But did you know that you can win all of life's battles? Within you is the power to be victorious. In fact, you can win the battles of life without even fighting. What? That just doesn't make sense. Well, Scripture tells us in different places that if we are truly a child of God, all we have to do is show up. In the 23rd chapter of Joshua we are told, "the Lord has driven out before you great and powerful nations; to this day no one has been able to withstand you. One of you routs a thousand, because the Lord your God fights for you, just as he promised." Do you see it? We just show up. The Lord fights for us. And if the Lord is fighting for us, what do you think our chances of winning the battle are? Some people are likely to say, "Yeah, but that's old testament stuff. 
