Look at this portion of Psalm 62:

Psalm 62:5–8 (ESV) For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken. On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is God. Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us. Selah

In this moment we must remember that it is God alone who can fully satisfy the longings of our hearts. So, as we wait, trust in Him. He is our unshakable rock. While we are limited in getting together, we are not limited in going to God. So, when you feel lonely, fearful, or stressed during this time run to God and pour out your heart to Him. For they gave according to their means, as I can testify, and beyond their means, of their own accord, begging us earnestly for the favor of taking part in the relief of the saints— and this, not as we expected, but they gave themselves first to the Lord and then by the will of God to us.

While we are not meeting and taking up a collection physically, I want to encourage you to continue to give faithfully to the Lord's work during this time. Finally, as we make our way through this challenging time being carried through by our Savior, let us continue to serve each other and pray for one another. Please share with the church family needs that may arise for you and your family.

I cannot tell you exactly what the near future looks like for us as the gathered church but I would like to tell you about our plan over the next couple of weeks. The plan, unless something changes, is to have drive up church service on both Sunday April 5 and Easter Sunday April 12 at 11:00am. We will also have the service streaming on Facebook live as well as being shown in a couple of areas in the church in case a few people need to get out of the heat. In an effort to follow our government's recommendations we do need to stay separate during the service but it will still be nice to be together at a distance. As we near Easter we will continue to monitor the situation and make adjustments and decisions about the future as the time nears. Please let me know if I can serve you in any way.

Let us pray that we would grow through these challenges and that we will be back together in fellowship soon.
