John brought up the Allaire Drive subdivision sale concern. It was brought to the attention of the town clerk that we are selling the lots without going to auction. In the March vote, the town voted on Article 24 and under section N it is believed that the Select Board can proceed with the sale. This property has gone to auction twice.

John spoke to someone at the DOJ. The town received a complaint about the June 21<sup>st</sup> special town meeting because this person is house bound and cannot make the meeting to vote. John asked DOJ for recommendations, and they recommended ZOOM. According to MMA and our town attorney doing ZOOM is illegal and states that remote voting cannot be done. Motion to affirm the vote on June 21<sup>st</sup> as previously planned, Katie **motioned**, Ron **seconded**, **all** in favor.

Deedee brought up that all new recreational department members and the two new EMA members need to come up to the town office and take their oath. Alesha will get in contact with them to come to the town office before June 30<sup>th</sup> and before July stipends are handed out.

BTH Birthday Party for June 18<sup>th</sup>- dependent on weather. Wade **motioned**, Gil **seconded**, **all** in favor.

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All Select Board members received the anticipated report from the DOJ on BTH. The biggest item of concern is the granite threshold. The other items of concerns are fixable, but John would like to set up an appointment with the DOJ to come out and meet with the Board and receive some clarity on the report.

We need a new Handicap sign posted by the main entrance, there is a spelling era. It will be taken care of asap.

The town charter article passed at the June 14<sup>th</sup> vote. Alesha will continue to keep on old business and John recommends all townspeople to come and express their opinions and stay involved as this process continues.
