Our Church Mission -Random Thoughts

All of us, whether healthy or unhealthy, young, or old, find it necessary to visit our physician on occasion. All the medical professionals first inquire into the state of the patient's health. The oximeter to measure the oxygen saturation level in the blood stream is placed on the finger, the weight is checked to determine whether we have been taking in excessive or poor quality nutrients, the heart rate and blood pressure is measured to determine if we can get oxygenated blood to all the body's cells. A stethoscope is used to hear if the heart or lungs have any abnormalities. At the summation of the examination the physician's advice usually always includes a statement to the effect younger folks are told by the physician to "quit eating junk food and eat your fruits and vegetables. Older folks usually are told to lose a few pounds and get more exercise. And so, it goes in our everyday lives.

Unfortunately, sometimes, some folks, if they don't like what the Dr. tells them, determine to quit that doctor and find another Doctor. Other folks just determine to quit going to the Dr. at all.

Occasionally one is required to have a physician's certificate of good health to assume new duties in the workplace which requires a revisit to the Doctor and new directives.

We, all of us, as members of College Park are collectively the church body. We may each be required during this period of church life to step up and undertake new roles in the service of worship to God," our Great Physician". To continue the mission of the church, it is time to assess the health of the church by going to the great physician. Is all the body receiving oxygenated blood from the heart? Is each member of the body receiving the nutrients of love, encouragement, forgiveness, and fellowship that God expects us to give one to another? Are we going before the Great physician in <u>prayer</u> to ask if our heart and lungs are strong enough to keep us in the race for the prize of the high calling in Christ Jesus that we are to be part of? Or, Is surgery by God necessary to repair a weakness that precludes us from knowing and attaining Gods will for each (and thus all) of our lives.

God, by His grace, gives us many opportunities to regroup, reexamine, check our health, and to unify in fulfilling our mission in service to Him. The mission of College Park Baptist Church has not and will not change. We are still admonished to "come together in love"; BE Present: To Humble ourselves and Pray": Be Patient, To Study the Word in order that we might be approved of God. But first we are to Pray for each other and for wisdom for each other. Please pray for the Pastor Search Committee as we ask God's will and for wisdom in the process of finding a new pastor and fulfilling our mission.

I will try to remember that I too must be <u>PRESENT</u>, <u>Participate</u> in Service to God and to each member, and be <u>Prayerful</u> in seeking God's will.


