- 1. Paul Thanked God, Praying. 2.
 - a. Paul prayed with his co-laborers. We.
 - b. Paul prayed faithfully. Always.
 - c. Paul had a prayer <u>life</u>. Our prayers.
- 2. Paul Thanked God, Remembering. 3.
 - a. Their work of faith your <u>purpose</u>: <u>why</u> you serve.
 - b. Their labour of love your <u>passion</u>: <u>how</u> you serve.
 - c. Their patience of hope your perseverance: how long your serve.
- 3. Paul Thanked God, Knowing. 4.
 - a. He knew they were fellow believers.
 - b. He knew they had <u>truly</u> been saved.
 - c. He knew his efforts had been successful.
