Call to Order

A call to order was made by Nick Lands at 7:02pm.

HYA Proposal

Issue 1 - Kids participating in both programs.

Agreement: Both HYA and SYSA will equitably share Saturday morning schedules, i.e. at least half of both programs Saturday schedules will be mornings.

Issue 2 - Bill Rice Complex and Multi-Use Fields.

SYSA and HYA discussed and came to a verbal agreement on fields being striped and used for both. Due to SYSA playing games at 5:30 during the week, HYA mentioned that flag football could hold practices early at the Bill Rice Complex and any later practice times would be moved to another location (if fields not available).

Parking being an issue was brought up by Heidi Flannery regarding the adjacent tower property that SYSA has no control over. She stated she has parked on the tower property and when it was time to leave, she was blocked in by vehicles. SYSA, HYA, and HTPD do not own this property so there is nothing SYSA can do to prevent that. SYSA does not have jurisdiction to barricade someone else's property.

Issue 3 – Master Schedule

SYSA cannot agree at this time to HYA Proposal over scheduling without discussing with the Park Director over issues and possible solutions.

Issue 4 – Concessions

Agreement: SYSA will retain concession stand. SYSA may, but will not be required, to run concession during flag football games.

Issue 5 – Advertising

SYSA and HYA agreed on allowing flag football fence sign advertisements during the flag football season. The signs will then be removed so SYSA can put up their fence sign advertisements for The Michael Herrin Soccer Tournament. SYSA would retain any revenue from field sign sponsors even though both programs share some fields.

Issue 6 – Field Maintenance

SYSA and HYA agreed on HYA splitting cost to Seed/Aerate/Fertilize/the 3 fields that are multipurpose striped for soccer and flag football.

Adjournment
