## I THESSALONIANS

Part Forty-One: "Excellence in Moral Purity, Part 7"

## Summary of I Thessalonians 4:3-8

Vs. 3 - Moral Purity is a matter of fulfilling my life's <u>purpose</u>.

For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication

Vs. 4 - Moral Purity is a matter of spiritual growth.

That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour

Vs. 5 - Moral Purity is a matter of knowing God.

Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God

Vs. 6 - Moral Purity is a matter of personal integrity.

That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.

Vs. 7 - Moral Purity is a matter of my <u>pursuit</u> of <u>holiness</u>.

For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

Vs. 8 - Moral Purity is a matter of my respect for God.

He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit.

- 1. These simple principles remind us from whom and what we are being <u>drawn</u> away when we are tempted to sin. James 1:14.
- 2. These simple principles confirm why it is essential for a believer to <u>strive</u> to <u>pursue</u> moral purity.
- 3. These simple principles help us to be <u>pulled</u> by <u>positive</u> ideas instead of merely running from dangerous temptations.
