

BY-LAW FOR LICENSING AND INSPECTION OF COIN OR DISC OPERATED
MACHIENES #82-16

BE IT ENACTED by Village Council of the Village of Blacks Harbour as follows:

1. In this By-Law:
 - (a) Council or Village Council shall mean the Council of the Village of Blacks Harbour;
 - (b) Committee shall mean a committee appointed by Council;
 - (c) Peace Officer means a duly sworn member of the Blacks Harbour Police Force;
 - (d) Child means a person under the age of fourteen years unless accompanied by a parent or guardian; or under the supervision of an adult of a non-profit organization.
 - (e) A non-profit organization means an organization whose main purpose is to provide a service to the Community which is recreational, cultural or social in nature and is not run as a business for personal gain.
 - (f) Person includes any company, corporation, owner, partnership, firm, association, society, party, tenant or individual;
 - (g) Coin machine means a machine operated for recreational or competitive games for a fee whether by insertion of a coin or disc or electronically controlled or by any other means. It shall not include slot machines as defined by the "Slot Machine Act" or any machine designed to give rides for children or any sound reproducing equipment;
 - (h) Residential zones mean a district defined as such in the Village of Blacks Harbour Zoning and Development By-Law;
 - (i) Premises means any building as defined as such in the Village of Blacks Harbour Zoning and Development By-Law C (commercial) Zone and is the only zone where coin machines may be operated;
 - (j) Administrator means the Village Clerk-Treasurer of the Village appointed by Village Council;
 - (k) School age child means a child as defined in the "School Act";
 - (l) Guardian means a person who has in law or in fact the custody of a child, and includes a person in whose home a child was placed as a foster child by a person having lawful authority;
