How Tightly Packed Were They? (San Jose Mercury-News) 7/26/84.

"Juice Newton and Huey Lewis were performing at the North Dakota State Fair to 18,000 fans, all of whom tried to stand directly in front of the stage. Scores of them dropped out from heat exhaustion because of body heat . . . a water tanker was brought in to spray the people in front of the stage to help keep them from fainting" said Leslie Moe, Chief of Security at the FAir. "People were passing out standing up" the astounded Moe said. "There was lots of room to the left and right of the stage, but everybody tried to get right in front of the stage." "They were tightly packed then?" reporters asked. "Tightly packed!" said Moe, who directed rescue (or extradition) efforts. "It was like pulling something out of a tire, they were so packed in there."
