"I love Juice Newton albums, I really do. They're like real music which is such a welcome relief in a world comprised of so much plastic and vinyl . . . Some artists are such a chore to have to listen to that I can't help but wonder why anyone would want to spend real dollars for them. On the other hand, Juice Newton's product is usually so vibrant and alive that I can't help but wonder why more people don't. By most definitions, she's a hit artist! . . . yet, her success seems so awfully quiet. We don't hear the stadium rocking with the chant 'Juice! Juice!' and we haven't seen the press and all the hype and all the other attendant hoopla that attempts to immortalize so many others whose music is bush league by comparison. But maybe that's about to change. Judging by the push RCA is putting on this latest album, maybe she's about to see her day in the sun, after all.

Understand, this woman is not one of those prefabricated mass-produced toys. She is a sensitive interpreter of the music she conveys, in a class with Linda Rondstadt and Emmylou Harris, among others. It's as though she respects the h--- out of the song and makes it part of her, This LP is one of her best in a while . . . and it's worth at least several spins in a row on the turntable."

The other nominees were: Emmylou Harris, Dolly Parton, Janie Fricke & Rosanne Cash. She received a Grammy a couple of years ago for singing "Break It To Me Gently" so awesomely! Juice will always be **Number One** in the hearts of her loyal fans!
