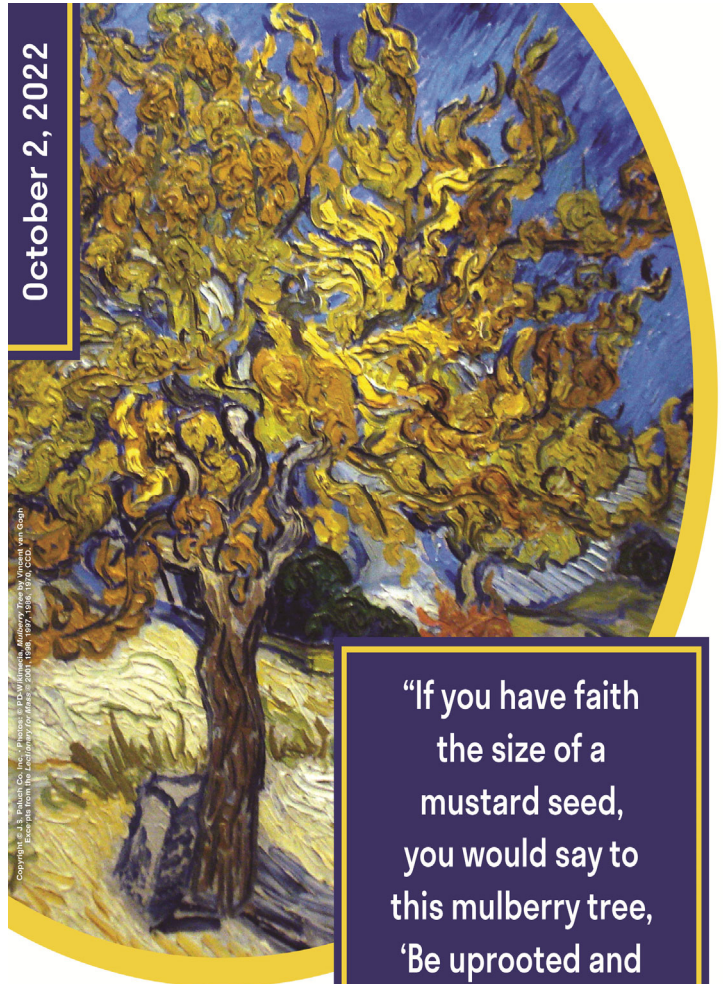

Saint Francis was born in Assisi in 1182; he had a special respect for ordained priests, regardless of their moral character, he held them in high esteem as he knew they were set apart by God for a special purpose; in his early twenties he converted to a life of prayer and he embraced poverty; he died in 1226 and was canonized just two years later.

Saint Faustina was born in Poland in 1905; in 1931, she had a vision, "King of Divine Mercy;" her confessor, spread the devotion and Novena of Divine Mercy; she died in 1938 and was canonized in 2000.

Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos was born in Germany in 1919; he served in a number of states and while serving in New Orleans he contracted Yellow Fever from the sick he was tending; he died in 1867 at the age of forty-eight.

Saint Bruno born in Cologne around 1035; he longed for a life of solitude and therefore founded the Carthusian Order; he died in 1101.

Blessed Marie Rose Durocher was born in Quebec in 1811; she founded the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary to work with poor children; she died in 1849.

Our Lady of the Rosary this Memorial was established by Pope Saint Pius V on the anniversary of the naval victory won by the Christian forces at Lepanto on October 7, 1571. It was in thanksgiving for the victory attributed to the Mother of God, whose aid had been invoked through the holy Rosary.

**Brothers and Sisters,**

Today's readings are all about faith, particularly the importance of being bold and never being ashamed of "witnessing for the Lord." Often, we feel that our faith is weak, unable to overcome all our doubts or give us the confidence to face the trials of our lives. Let me share with you some thoughts I have about faith. There is a small, framed definition of faith that hangs in a friend's home. It goes something like this "Faith is not knowing what the future holds, but knowing who holds the future." Sometimes I think of faith as a many faceted jewel. Faith is persistence in reaching out to Jesus and trusting in God's power and authority, it is responding with love to forgiveness received, not letting fear get the upper hand, and being willing to take risks. Faith is giving praise to God, having confidence in God's desire for justice and being willing to ask Jesus for what we need.



In today's first reading from the prophet Habakkuk, the prophet is living in a time of "destruction and violence...strife and discord." He cries out for God's help, but feels God is not listening to him. Does that feeling sound familiar to you? God tells Habakkuk to have faith, assuring him that faith gives hope and life to the just one. And in our second reading St. Paul tells Timothy that faith and love can be found in Christ Jesus.

Throughout Luke's gospel, Jesus' closest followers reveal their own mixed level of faith. They have left homes, jobs and family in order to follow Jesus. It hasn't been easy, as they have encountered hostility from many who oppose him. Still, they have stuck around, even for the final journey towards Jerusalem, even after they have received a warning of what is to come. In today's world of turmoil and fear, we can empathize with the disciples when their faith waivers. Yet when we nurture faith we become aware of being part of something vast that gives purpose to life, that leads us to seek beyond our own horizons to the hope that tomorrow, struggling and damaged as we may be today, we can all be better. Faith in God is the only real ground we have for faith in ourselves, in humanity, in life.

Just as our own priest chaplain, Fr. Adri Budhi in his visits to the hospital ministers to people in need, the patients, families and staff-so are we called upon to witness to Christ and to use our God-given gifts to serve others and bring healing. We are called to bear witness to Jesus right where we live, in our families, at work, everywhere-even just by giving kindness and the light of a smile. This light reflects the light of Jesus. We can demonstrate the beauty of the gift of faith by the way we live. When religious faith becomes the bridge that leads to God, it stretches us to live to the limits of human possibility. It requires us to be everything God has created us to be: kind, generous, honest, loving, compassionate, just. It defines the standards of the human condition. It provides the basis for the ethics that guide our human relationships. It enables us to be fully human. So let us fan the flames of faith to serve others and the common good.

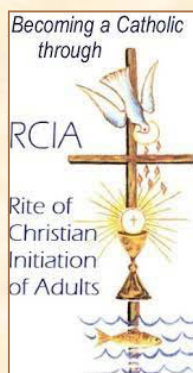

**San Francisco** nació en Asís en 1182; tenía un respeto especial por los sacerdotes ordenados, independientemente de su carácter moral, los tenía en alta estima porque sabía que estaban apartados por Dios para un propósito especial; a los veinte años se convirtió a una vida de oración y abrazó la pobreza; murió en 1226 y fue canonizado sólo dos años después.

**Santa Faustina** nació en Polonia en 1905; en 1931 tuvo una visión, "Rey de la Divina Misericordia"; su confesor, difundió la devoción y la Novena de la Divina Misericordia; murió en 1938 y fue canonizada en 2000.

**El Beato Francisco Javier Seelos** nació en Alemania en 1919; sirvió en varios estados y mientras servía en Nueva Orleans contrajo la Fiebre Amarilla de los enfermos que atendía; murió en 1867 a la edad de cuarenta y ocho años.

**San Bruno** nació en Colonia hacia el año 1035; anhelaba una vida de soledad y por ello fundó la Orden de los Cartujos; murió en 1101.

**La beata María Rosa Durocher** nació en Quebec en 1811; fundó las Hermanas de los Santos Nombres de Jesús y María para trabajar con los niños pobres; murió en 1849.

**Nuestra Señora del Rosario** este monumento fue establecido por el Papa San Pío V en el aniversario de la victoria naval obtenida por las fuerzas cristianas en Lepanto el 7 de octubre de 1571. Fue en acción de gracias por la victoria atribuida a la Madre de Dios, cuya ayuda había sido invocada a través del santo Rosario.
