Our lawn and snow service removes snow and puts out snow melt on the same schedule as the Village of Windsor. This does not necessarily occur right at the start of a snow or ice event and does not necessarily continue throughout the event. Even after snow and ice removal takes place, there can be melting and refreezing as the sun and cloud conditions change throughout the day.

While the staff will do its best to remove snow and ice after a weather event, we cannot keep roadways and walks absolutely clear of ice 24 hours a day. Make sure to exercise caution during this winter snow and ice season when leaving and entering buildings, driving on the roads and parking lots, and walking among the buildings here at Parkside Village.
